Harrington, who has been very active in banking circles throughout New England for many years, is well known to bankers in Connecticut.

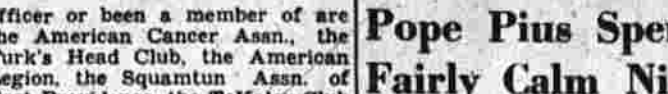

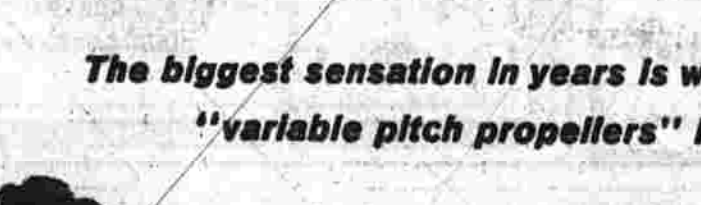

What Communist Motive?

Why has Communist China up to the present time been so successful in its highly publicized campaign to free 13 American prisoners as well as to possess the wisdom to conceive and carry out an American policy which could have avoided it.

Our post-war policy in both Germany and Japan has held a very clear pattern. In each instance, our drive has been to support in office a regime to which we could have had national sovereignty without fear of a loss of friendship and influence for ourselves, and individual statesmen, like Yoshida and Aomori, have been the implementers we have sought to use.

What else could we do, or should we have done? It is difficult to imagine how we could have played the game any other way. We could not like and support Yoshida, the loss because he played the game the way we wanted to have it played.

Yet the inevitable consequence of such a good partnership is that Yoshida comes to wear the American label in a country defeated and occupied by America, and that he is classified as an American agent in the United States.

There is a third possibility, that this is not a Chinese Communist action alone, but a play made with the advice of Russian diplomacy as well. In that event, the play could be interpreted as one designed to throw American policy in the world off balance by precipitating violent domestic debate, and by shifting American policy away from its recent pre-occupation with peace and co-existence back to talk and threat of war and blockade.

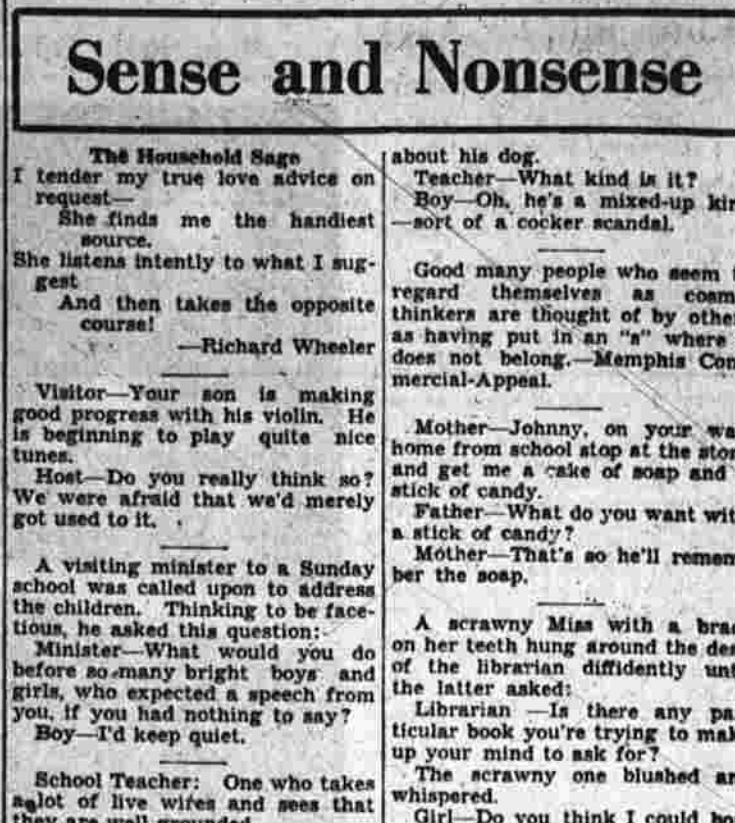
