Pontiff 'Better,' Doctors Report

Vatican City, Dec. 4 (AP)—Pope Pius XII got a little better again today and specialists dispelled fears that the seriously ailing Pontiff has cancer.

"Two clinical experts who took part in a bedside conference last night said the Pope was not suffering from a tumor or any of the digestive tubes.

The 72-year-old head of the Roman Catholic Church suffered a collapse Thursday that brought his close to death. But his sturdy heart pulled him through that crisis and through the hours that allowed him to strengthen.

Morning Report

"Everything looks better," Dr. Luciano Castellani, a Vatican spokesman, said as he returned to the papal apartment earlier today to issue the morning communiqué.

The statement containing the report said:

"The clinical doctors consulted yesterday, Prof. Antonio Garbafoglio and the Surgeon Prof. Raffaele Imbriani of Valmaggiore issued the following report:

"The clinical facts resulting from the history, notwithstanding the fact we could not make a complete radiological examination, exclude there being any tumor of any of the digestive tubes.

"The hicups from which the Holy Father suffered at various times can be attributed to gastric irritation or excessive flat.

"Because also of the high gastric acidity controlled, it is not to be excluded that a local condition could have contributed to the beginning of the syndrome (a group of symptoms).

"From an objective point of view the condition of the cardio-circulatory apparatus are in optimum condition, the lungs are unaffected.

"The abdomen is soft and free of liquid; it is tractable in all its quadrants, painful only at the superior right one (quadrant) where on the other side the Holy Father for years has suffered from such pain.
