**Roach Experiment Shows Invasion of Home Possible**  
 Berkeley, Calif., Dec. 27 (AP)—Radioactive cockroaches have demonstrated how the species can invade homes even passing through water traps in the plumbing, two U. S. public health experts reported today.

Several cockroaches in Phoenix, Ariz., were registered for the experiment. The results showed that the insects, which are potential disease carriers, migrate as much as 300 feet when they become overexposed or when forced out of their colonies by bucket-of-sewage.

The experiment was reported to the American Assn. for the Advancement of Science (AAS) by William R. Jackson and Paul F. Maloney of the Public Health Service Communicable Disease Center in Atlanta, Ga.

It was carried out by playing a sort of dirty trick on the insects. The roaches in one sewer manhole were lured out with ripe bananas and collected with a vacuum cleaner.

These insects were sprayed with radioactive phosphorus, which did not burn them but made them traceable with a Geiger counter. They were caught in their hole. Then another colony of 1,000 roaches was trapped from a nearby manhole and dumped into the radioactive cockroaches.

The second group of roaches was not made radioactive.

That produces congestion, crowding and see how many of the radioactive insects get away from their home under such conditions.

In cold weather the migrating roaches didn't go far, but when it warmed up they went off in all directions. They were caught in their hole. Then another colony of 1,000 roaches was trapped from a nearby manhole and dumped into the radioactive cockroaches.

The second group of roaches was not made radioactive.

That produces congestion, crowding and see how many of the radioactive insects get away from their home under such conditions.

**Red China Given Control of Airline**  
 Hong Kong, Dec. 27 (AP)—The New China News Agency said today preparations are complete for the transfer of Russian shares in the Sino-Soviet Civil Aviation Corp. to Communist China's government.

The corporation's equipment, supplies, fuel and buildings were transferred to Communist China this month, it said. Traffic resumed for the first quarter of 1955, it reported to have been worked out with the help of the Russians.

The Peiping Radio said last month that Red China is taking over the airline system, operated by the corporation, now flies four major routes, all radiating into or toward Russian territory. One goes via Mongolia to Moscow, another to Manchuria and on to Alaska, Siberia, and on to Tokyo.

The airline system was established in 1950 with Soviet planes and equipment.

**Oppenheimer Aims Views on Science**  
 New York, Dec. 27 (AP)—Atomic physicist J. Robert Oppenheimer, who has been named to head the Atomic Energy Commission, aims to give his views on science and the role of the scientist in society.

Oppenheimer, who got caught up in one of the world's current complications last June when the Atomic Energy Commission barred him from its secrets as a security risk, said in a nationwide radio speech yesterday.

"There has always been more to know than one man could know... Yet never before today has the integrity of the scientist, the integrity of the true art, the integrity of craftsmanship and preservation of the family of the humankind and the beautiful world of science, chemical order and simplification..."

Oppenheimer's speech, entitled "Prospects in the Arts and Sciences," was the final one in a series commemorating the 200th anniversary of Columbia University.
