United Nations N. Y., Jan. 14 (AP)—Dag Hammarskjold said today his Peiping talks achieved what he had intended—a clarification of the views of both sides. The U.N. Secretary General said the door is open to further contacts, but declined to define the next step toward release of the 11 American flyers jailed by the Chinese government.

He said Chou En-lai, premier, and foreign minister of Red China, had laid down the terms for a new conference. He added no deals had been suggested either by him or Chou.

The program, which was authorized in 1954, has called a closed-door conference with Congress today to seek removal of the restrictions.
