China Regains Focus

An unusual conversion of mood and ideology passed virtually unnoticed in the nation's news the other day, not being labeled as news, but it is of great importance. It would surprise to be taken at first, at face value. But close examination of the speech in which it was revealed makes it stand up.

The speaker was Henry Cain, former Republican Senator from Washington, and now a member of the Subversive Activities Control Board. The defeat of Cain, as he sought reelection in 1952, was one of the symbols of the way Americans were voting in that year. For Eisenhower, overwhelmingly, but far less enthusiastically than members of the extreme right wing of the Republican party. All these, from McCarthy himself on down, ran behind Eisenhower, and frequently as violent as he in his public pronouncements, ran far enough behind to be defeated.

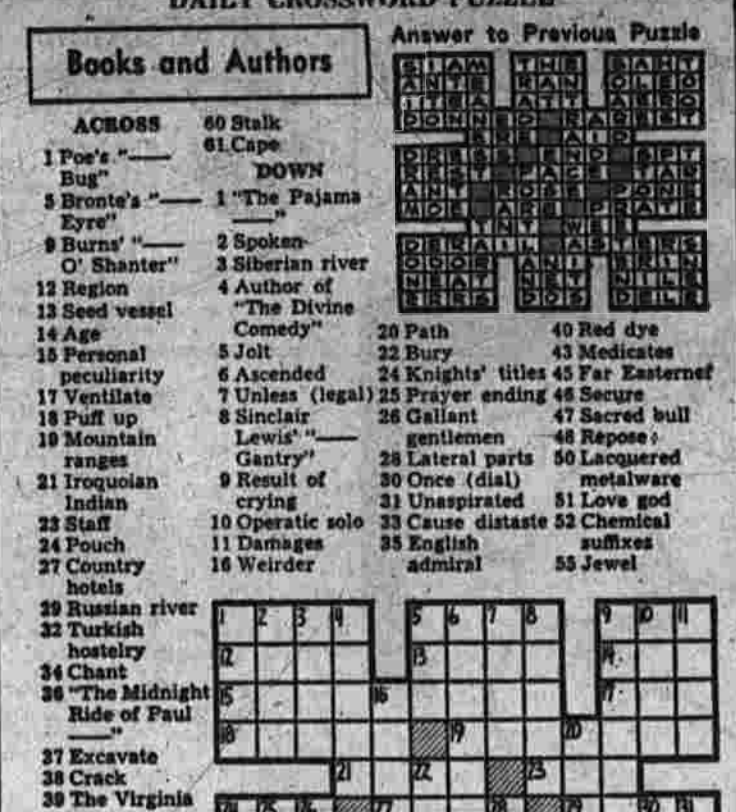
