Measles, Viruses Causing Absenteeism in Schools

An epidemic of measles, viruses... Measles, viruses causing absenteeism in schools... Dr. Joseph Barry, school health officer, reported today that absenteeism in the elementary school was between 10 and 15 per cent.

In the high school today, Principal Edson M. Bailey reported that 137 of the more than 800 morning-session students were absent. This is almost 18 per cent absenteeism, high even for this time of year, Bailey said.

Most of the high school absences were attributed to a combination of colds and the weather. In the lower grades, however, particularly among first, second and third grade children, it was the childhood disease, the measles, which was keeping youngsters home.

The Health Dept. said more than 250 cases of measles had been reported since Jan. 1. This is high compared with other years and is almost three times the number of all communicable diseases reported.
