Rockville, Feb. 4 (Special)—County Coroner Bernard J. Ackerman issued a report today clearing Miss Julia Case, 26, of Mansfield, of any criminal act or carelessness in the recent deaths of Mrs. Marie A. Nelson, 31, and her young son, Pierre, age three, of Mansfield. Mrs. Nelson and her son were killed Jan. 15 about 7 p. m. when they were struck by a car operated by Miss Case. They were walking with traffic in a southerly direction on Route 59 in the vicinity of Bassett's Bridge, Mansfield.

According to the report, shortly before the fatal accident, several motorists had been held in their position of peril and at least one of them had turned sharply to avoid hitting them. This motorist, who was driving a brown Ford sedan, was identified as Mrs. Nelson and her son were wearing dark clothing and were not wearing a brown fur coat and Pierre was wearing a blue hat.

It is this possibility of a Communist desperation and a brave and bold American position which cannot be altered, at least, during the present phase of the problem, which strikes a deep chill into the hearts of many Americans, and leads some fervent to the efforts of those who would still try to avoid war. It must be hoped that there is more reassurance behind the scenes than appears on the surface.
