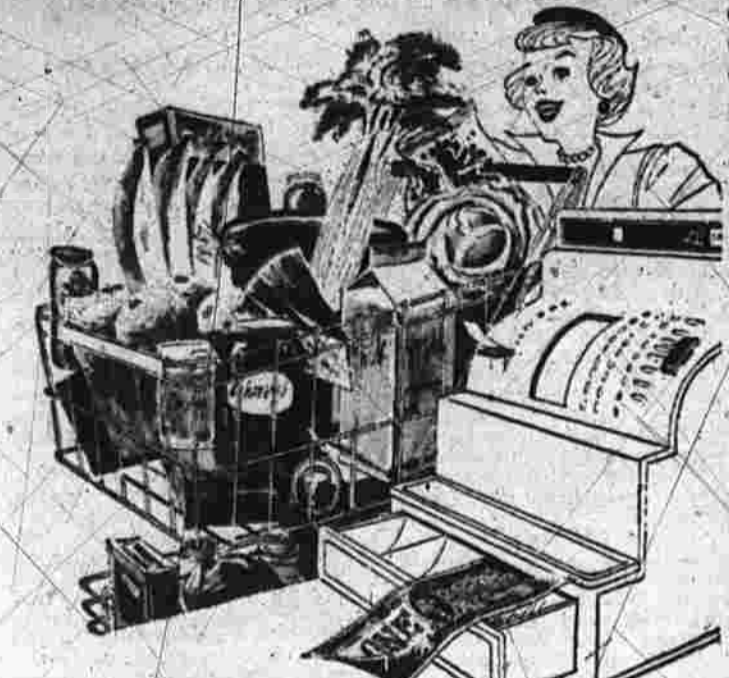

It is understood that the pact Turkey is linked with Pakistan in a separate defense alliance. Pakistan is outside NATO and has a military aid agreement with the United States.
