Israel Buys Four Oldest Bible Scrolls

Jerusalem, Israel (AP)—After a seven-year quest, Israel has bought from the Syrians for a reported \$250,000 four "dead sea scrolls," described as the oldest known Bible manuscripts.

Prime Minister Moshe Shertok announced that purchase of the scrolls, discovered in a cave near Jericho in 1947, had finally been negotiated by Mal Gen. Yigal Yadin, former Israeli army chief of staff and son of the late Ben-Zion L. Senuki, of the Hebrew University.

Sherk was the first research student to identify the scrolls as dating from 70 A.D. or before.

The scrolls are manuscript of the Book of Isaiah, the Commentary of Habakkuk, a book of regulations of a Monastic sect called Essenes, and the Book of Enoch, an apocryphal work whose existence is referred to in the Bible.

They have been held since their discovery by the Syrian Metropolitan at St. Mark's Cathedral in the Arab-held city of Jerusalem. The Book of Enoch is still unopened, but it has been identified by detached fragments.

Yadin identified the purchase from the Syrian archbishop when he was in the United States last year. Money for the deal was provided by the Palestine Fund for Israel Institutions headed by Edward Sherman of New York.

Controls Eased In Coffee Trade

Washington, March 1 (AP)—In an effort to stabilize coffee prices and prevent a recurrence of last year's upward price spiral, more coffee futures are going to be traded on the open market.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) announced yesterday that the New York Coffee Exchange and Clearing House has accepted a consent order to broaden trading.

In the past, only Brazilian coffee and less than 10 per cent of U.S. imports have been subject to trading. Under the new agreement, coffee from four other Latin American countries will be included, an expansion that FTC estimates will cover 70 to 75 per cent of imports.

The tentative order, subject to approval by the full commission, also would drop charges of unlawful restraint of trade against the exchange, which did not concede truth of the charges.

Under the order, a review every six months will attempt to make sure that futures market conditions reflect spot market activity.
