

Rockville-Vernon GOP Accepts Merger Study, Stipulations Made by Club

Rockville, April 6 (Special)— Damages of \$6,000 were asked in the proposed study of whether the City of Rockville and Town of Vernon should merge. At a meeting of the GOP group last night, the group voted to accept the invitation extended recently by the members of the opposing political party, however, the Republicans must approve the stipulations that be non-partisan, non-sectional and an objective project. The Republican Club said that any committee named to make the study should consist of four members from each unit with two of each four, residents of each town.

Norman Strong and Robert Keane were selected by the club as its representatives from rural Vernon and Joseph Williams and Henry Billie from the city. The Democratic Club revealed plans for a meeting next Wednesday and said the Research Committee will make its report on how it feels the two towns should merge.

It was pointed out that it may be impossible to have the bill introduced during the present session, but the club felt the importance of its proposal to have the juvenile courts handle offenders up to 18 years of age warranted the effort.



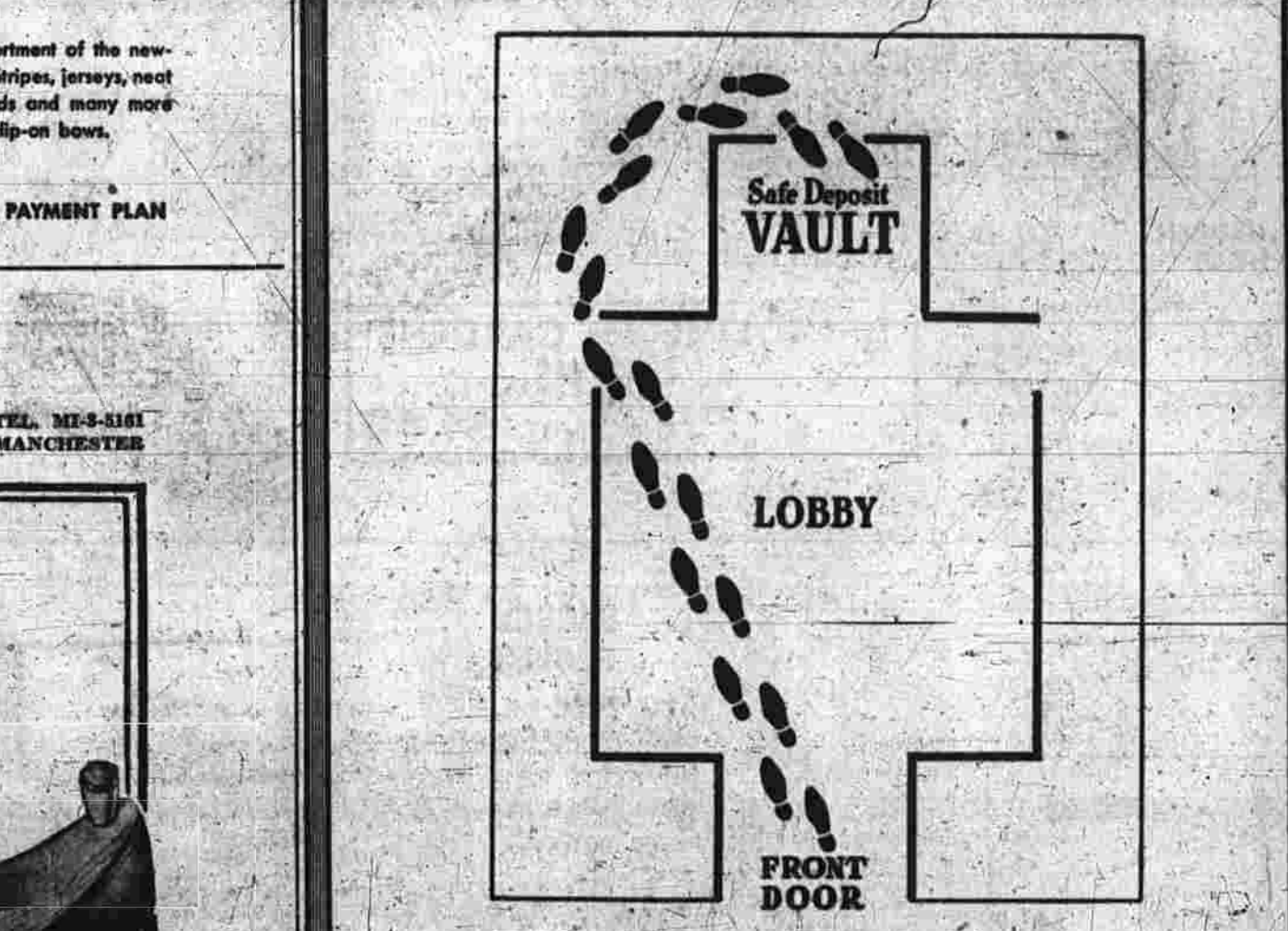
