As for Austria, it stends by helpless, wondering if its best friends are going to put a last minute gimmick in its possibility of freedom. And the answer seems to be that if we thought we could spoil a play by Russia, we would be very happy to postpone Austria's treaty once again. We have been quibbling, at Vienna, over things we ourselves accepted long ago. For both sides, Austria is still little more than a pawn. It's a shabby game, and it is to be devoutly hoped that we cease our part in it immediately, and let the treaty be signed.

Chou gave a sign of this new strategy on his part at the Bandung Conference, where he paid most attention, and gave most of his hints of peace, to Pakistan, India's rival. And his whoic effort at Bandung was to build himself up as his own man of peace, in contrast to the picture of somebody who could only be persuaded to peace by somebody like Nehru.
