Washington, May 31 (P)—The Supreme Court, fixing no specific deadline, directed today that race segregation in all public schools be ended as soon as feasible.

The High Tribunal's unanimous decision in effect toesed the whole explosive problem to local school authorities and to lower federal courts.

The Supreme Court said the lower courts should see to i that school authorities "make a prompt and reasonable start toward complying with its finding of last year that segregation is unconstitutional."
