

Rockville-Vernon School Budget Up \$35,593; Await Special Meeting Vote

Rockville, June 2 (Special)—A proposed budget of \$77,120 was presented to the Board of Education Monday night. The budget for the 1958-1959 school year, an increase of \$35,593 over the 1957-1958 budget, was taken up by the board. The budget was approved by a vote of 10-0. The board will meet again on June 10 to discuss the budget.

Special mention was made of the estimated income for the year which would total \$28,550. It was brought out that this is \$4.9 per cent of the total estimated expense, which would bring the total to \$77,120.

Estimated grants include: Equalization, \$12,000; general state, \$1,000; special education, \$240; trade school training, \$1,000; federal aid, \$2,000; federal aid, agriculture, \$2,000; federal aid, education, \$2,000.
