Andover Books Balance for Menus Served During School Year

Andover, July 20 (Special)—Parents who expressed their approval of last year's well-balanced lunch program will be interested in knowing that careful administration produced equally well-balanced books, according to officials.

Total income for the year amounted to \$12,083.87 and total expenditures were only \$11,804.56. Under the program, which operated 177 out of 180 school days, 37,083 children's lunch menus were served and 2,661 free lunches, in addition to 2,468 adult lunches which were paid for and 443 adult lunches which were free.

Yousang in the elementary grades consumed 79,784 bottles of milk at a cost of \$3,831.40. The State reimbursed the program 3-cents for each bottle over a total of 431 secured each day. According to a recently passed bill, the program will receive 3-cents per bottle on all milk this year.

Of the total income received, \$2,487.72 was realized from paid lunches; \$1,706.97 was allowed by the State for the lunch program and \$7,889.18 came in from the State for milk. The old store was sold to the Lake Association for \$35, and \$374.74 came in from last year's accounts receivable. Only \$380.79 remains on the books this year for unpaid lunches.

The total food cost was \$6,693.05; wages, \$4,602; miscellaneous, \$111.51.
