No definite conclusions could be drawn about the number of persons threatened by the loosened torrent, but officials in Coventry said it might pose a serious threat to the city of Willimantic.

### Rockville Tolland County Budget Report Set at \$59,889

Rockville, Aug. 19 (Special).—A preliminary budget report was presented to the County Legislature for discussion last night at a public hearing.

Prepared by the County Commissioner, the budget was broken into three major categories: County Home, with a request of \$130,000; Jail, with a request of \$35,517; and Miscellaneous, with a request of \$22,372.

The Commissioner estimated receipts to total \$118,991 for the same period, exclusive of County tax to towns.

### Bethroth Athenian Fleet Thought Found Off Sicily Coast

Syracuse, Sicily, Aug. 19 (AP).—Drivers have found water-logged hulls experts believe are those of a Greek war fleet lost 2,388 years ago in one of the greatest naval defeats of ancient history.

The first ancient wreckage was sighted this week by men who have been working for almost a month in the salt at the bottom of the broad bay of Syracuse, on the southeast coast of Sicily.

"They described the gaunt ribs and sharp prow of what appeared to be an ancient trireme, a galley with three banks of oars. The wooden wreckage crumbled at their touch."

No Doubt of Finding  
"There can be no doubt," said Prof. Luigi Bernardini, director of the Syracuse Historical Museum, "that the wreckage is from the Athenian fleet that perished at Salamis, 480 B.C., and their children, Robert 7, and Diane, 3, were present."

"We stand at the threshold of a discovery of perhaps the most ancient warships ever found on earth."

The total number of claims in the State dropped from 31,330 to 27,188 as the number of vacation annuities fell off from 4,226 to 460 and the number of initial claims declined from 9,224 to 4,111. About two thirds of the decline in initial claims was a result of the slackening of the summer 2-week period. Initial claims dropped to 371 from 6,438.
