White House Aide Unsure Ike to Run
 Washington, Aug. 22 (AP)—A top White House aide says "it would be helpful" if President Eisenhower seeks reelection, but that those who express confidence he will do so "are perhaps more hopeful than certain."
 Howard Pyle, who made the comment during a radio-TV interview yesterday, said he for some time has known whether Eisenhower will run again. Pyle, a former Governor of Arizona, is now a presidential assistant on state-federal relations.
 Eisenhower himself has given no direct indication of his plans, but numerous Republicans have been planning their campaigns on the assumption that he will be a candidate.
 "If he is not, Pyle said, "then both parties will have a free for all." "Probably" Candidates would trail in line rapidly," he predicted, but he named only Vice President Nixon as a possible challenger.
 Asked whether he thought Nixon could defeat Adlai Stevenson, the 1952 Democratic nominee, Pyle first said "I don't know whether he could or not." He later said, however, "I do not believe that he would."

Bay State Polio Decline Forecast
 Boston, Aug. 22 (AP)—Massachusetts health officials looked for a continued decline in polio cases this week, as Boston yesterday reported only eight cases, five less than the previous Sunday.
 The state figure for the year so far is 1,218 cases, with 56 deaths reported, two yesterday. Eight deaths were reported last year at this time.

 Among those welcoming Khrushchev was M. B. Mitin, editor of the publication which serves as mouthpiece for the Cominform, which has its headquarters in Bucharest.
 Other hands were Romanian Premier Gheorghiu-Dej and delegations from North Korea, East Germany and Czechoslovakia who had come for the celebration tomorrow.

Army Chief Urges Combat Readiness
 Philadelphia, Aug. 22 (AP)—Secretary of the Army William M. Bruebel called today for continued "firm and sustained combat readiness" despite the hope for peace.
 In an address prepared for the annual meeting of the American War Assn. he said the summit meeting at Geneva last month has given us some reason to hope for the gradual lessening of world tensions and the eventual establishment of a stable order based on justice.
 "But he added that it would be tragic to take counsel of mere wishful thinking and to permit premises allow our military might to deteriorate.
 It would be "extremely foolhardy," he said, for the United States to forget the threat of Communist "violence, tyranny, duplicitous subversion and armed aggression, and an insupportable mistake for us to forget that the foundation of peace is the collective strength of the Free World."
 Certainly we must be prepared to fight and to win if our most conscientious efforts to preserve peace should prove unavailing," he said.

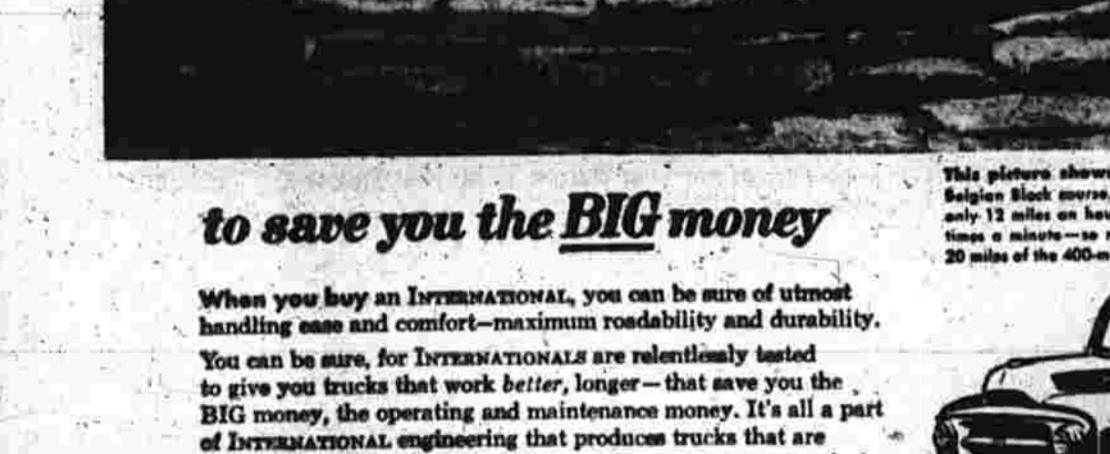
