Japan Milk Firm Sorry for Deaths
 Tokyo, Sept. 1 (AP)—Morinaga Milk Co., affiliated with one of Japan's largest food combines, today offered its "humblest apology" for the 90 deaths reported caused by arsenic in its dried milk product last week.
 In a black-bordered, four-column advertisement carried in all Japanese and English language papers, the company said: "We are filled with a sense of black guilt, particularly on learning that the cause of the disaster was arsenic on our part to subject the stabilizer (arsenic) used in the milk to careful chemical analysis... all we can do is to take every possible action by way of indemnification and pray for the souls of the dead."

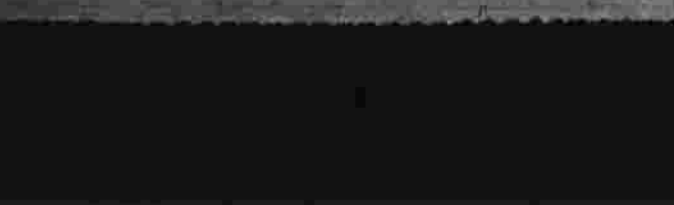

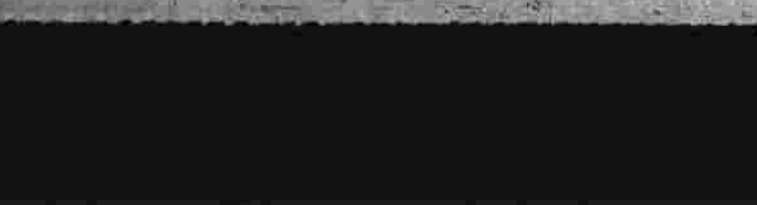

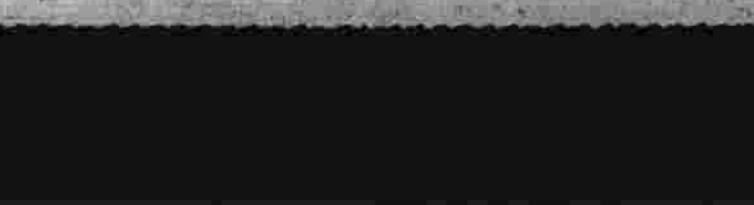
