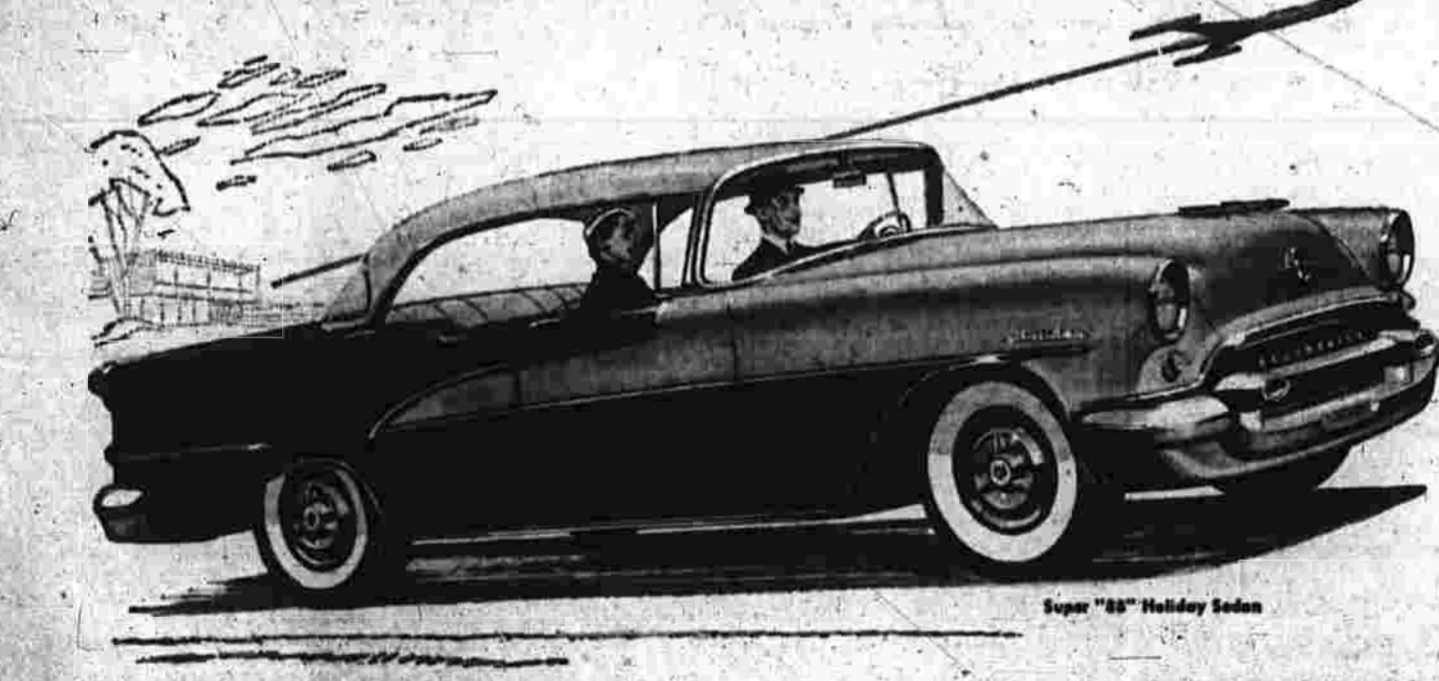

Intercontinental Ice Missiles Seen Possible Test Device

Albuquerque, Sept. 13 (AP)—An "shrewd opponent" could wage an ice cube test against the country with intercontinental projectiles made of ice.

The object of the ice missile would be to determine effectiveness of range for a missile of this size.

Dr. Lincoln La Paz, director of the University of New Mexico's Institute of Meteorology, the only one of its kind in the Western world, said:

"Ice is the most fragile of materials. It melts rapidly in the atmosphere. It is a shrewd opponent for obvious reasons leaving no tangible traces of its existence or use."

It is for this reason that about 1948, representatives of the Institute of Meteorology and other luminous phenomena in yellow or red pieces of ice or drops of water were detected falling from the sky at the time of the observation.

Observers have reported drops of water.

But another meteorologist, John David Bushong of Pasadena, Calif., said he discovered the same thing from the sky either during a storm or a clear day.

Union Threats At State Mental Hospital Cited

Hartford, Sept. 13 (AP)—Dr. John Blisko, state mental health commissioner, says the use of threats by union members in State mental hospitals is lowering morale.

Blisko charged last night that union members had actually used threats of physical harm to employees who would not cooperate.

He said in one instance two union ward aides had warned a non-union ward aide that he would not be helped if he was attacked by a patient.

Blisko said the union methods were designed to "conquer, persist and annoy" in order to fulfill demands that have been particularly insistent in the last six months.

Three union representatives were in state hospitals at Middletown, Preston and Newtown. One of the unions denied such activity.

Blisko said that he has a strong feeling that union activity in Connecticut hospitals has helped to raise standards, and is in complete sympathy with union principles and goals, but do not think that the methods should be the same as those used in private industry where one works with machinery on a one shift day and in paper work.

"When they (the unions) use their methods so successfully with private industry, these methods produce a great deal of harm as well as good," Blisko said.

Mrs. Patricia Smith, director for Connecticut government employees in public of the CIO, said her union did not want to get in a public controversy with the commission.

"It is regrettable that a serious situation does exist and that problems stemming from unfair and unjust treatment of mental hospital employees have led the employees to demand that they be represented."

She said the union intends to discuss the situation with Gov. Ribicoff.

Meanwhile, Bernard McCusker, executive director of the Connecticut State Employees Assn. (Ind) said:

"I am confident that the implication in the commissioner's release does not involve the Connecticut State Employees Assn., as these are not the type of methods employed by the association."

Officials of the third union, American Federation of State, Local and Municipal Employees Council (AFL), could not be reached for comment.

Legion Clears UNESCO Of Communist Charges

Washington, Sept. 13 (AP)—An official American Legion committee has termed "utterly without foundation" charges that the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) is a Communist front.

Summarizing an 18-month investigation in the controversial "UNESCO is not favorable to world government" report, the committee said UNESCO is not a Communist front.

The report was signed by Chairman Ray Murphy, former national commander from Iowa who now lives in New York City, and five other members: Jacob Ark of New York, Paul M. Harbord of Ohio, Rev. Gordon L. Kidd of New York, William G. McKinley of New Jersey, and Harold E. Burdett of New York, onetime head of the United Nations.

UNESCO is an independent affiliate of the United Nations. It is supported by a \$21-million-a-year budget, with the United States contributing little over 2 million of that—some 56 U.S. citizens work at UNESCO headquarters in New York, with about 20 others in UNESCO missions throughout the world.

The organization's stated aim is to work for peace through educational, scientific and cultural channels on the world.

"That since we begin in the minds of men, it is in the minds of men that the disease of peace must be constructed."

That Alger Hiss called in a Communist front organization to help the State Department plan UNESCO, Hiss is a former State Department official who served a prison term after his conviction of lying in denying he passed government secrets to a prewar spy ring. The Legion committee said there is no record of any activity by Mr. Hiss in connection with the formation of UNESCO.

That the late Harry Dexter White, wartime high Treasury official described by Atty. Gen. Brown as a Russian spy and agent, gave particular attention to the establishment of UNESCO at San Francisco in 1945. The committee said a study of UNESCO documents showed the agency was not established at San Francisco, but at London, and that White did not "the remotest connection" with it.
