Boileggers Use Illegal Bath Tub

Anderson, S. C. (AP)—Boileggers hereabouts have a new gimmick that presents a nice legal question for officers.

Sheriff Clint McClain reports that some of the boileggers in illegal houses empty a case at a time into a bathtub, and get the water in a bathtub in their homes.

Christ's Language Used for Masses

Jacksonville, Fla. (AP)—Jacksonville is one of the few cities in America where divine services are held in the language spoken by Christ.

Each morning at 6:30 in Holy Trinity Catholic Church, Rev. Andrew Sashy says Mass in the ancient Syriac language according to the liturgy of Antioch. The liturgy is derived from the Apostles James.

Because there has been no English translation of the services available, Father Sashy, a priest of the Holy Trinity, has had to rely upon Joseph Redinger, 80, scholar and language master, to undertake the task.

Redinger began in 1922 so that the service could be made available to those who cannot read the original. He has just finished it.

Explaining the ancient Syriac language, he says: "The Syriac language is the same as the Aramaic language during the Babylonian Captivity of 43 years and this had developed into the West Aramaic or Syriac language as a result of the changing five centuries."

New York took over in the eighth inning. The Yanks tied the game with a two-run homer by Ted Williams, who came in as a pinch-hitter and an important "hot" column. New York has won 60 and lost 56, with nine games remaining. Cleveland, which has won 52 and lost 64, has one game left.

Chicago's White Sox practically fell out of the fight with a 13-7 thrashing at Kansas City. The Indians played to the bill the "spoiler" role it shares with Detroit. A three-run surge chased starter Whitford from the eighth and gave the Red Sox a 4-3 advantage. "It's a twinkling, it's all over."

Bauer continued on a 3-1 pitch of Kinder, who by baselined standard was drawing a Social Security. The 41-year-old right-hander got a ball and a strike and a home run.

In the process of claiming the lead for the first time since 1943, the Yankees lost Mickey Vernon, who heads the league with 37 homers. He pulled a muscle in his right arm while batting for Bill Sullivan in the second inning. An official report on the injury will have to wait until Mickey Vernon is back in the lineup.
