

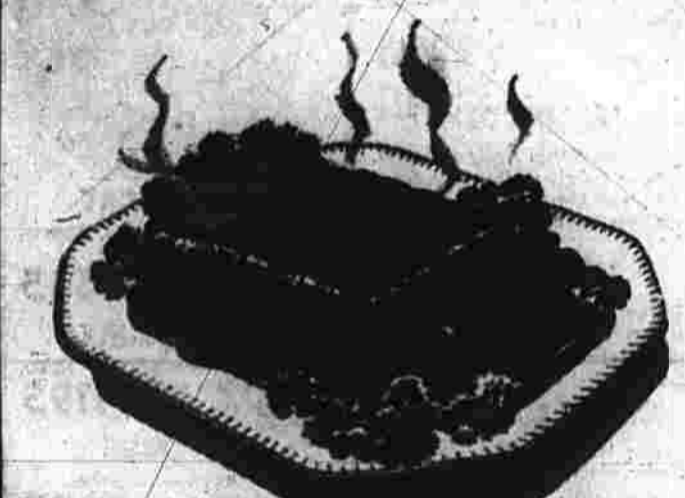

### Hal Boyle What Girls Think Of Manless World

New York City — Guess what is the single thing that makes the world most livable to women.

It's you, mister, whether you're single or not. Most girls agree they wouldn't want to live—even doubt that they could live—in a world that held no man.

"They simply couldn't get along without our shy, manly dimples, our little, pointed heads, our bumbling S-shumb hands."

Yes, sir, but do you know what the girls would miss most about men if the male sex suddenly vanished from the earth? Well, no matter what you're thinking, you're wrong.

The right answer: The thing they'd miss most is—a man's conversation. At least that's what they claim themselves.

The possibility of a manless world exists. Two scientists at the University of Iowa have created a womanless world of frogs by treating some male frogs with female hormones. The confused he-frogs began laying eggs, but all the offspring hatched out male. Not a girl tadpole in a carload.

Theoretically, a one-sex race of human beings is also possible, but it would work, the other way: Fathers couldn't become mothers. But hormones-treated mothers could act as fathers. Unfortunately, all their children would be girls. There would be no more ill boys.

I polled a dozen ladies—young, middle-aged and elderly—on how they would like life in a world made up forever only of members of their own sex. Most of them agreed they'd rather be dead.

Here are a few of their reactions:

"You mean I'd have to pay my own way when I went out? That'd kill me!"

"It would be too lonely without men. Nobody to fight with. Sure women fight each other, but it's not fun. It's only fun when you're fighting a man."

"Whose shoulder would I cry on? I hate other women."

"It would be a more sensible world if there were no more. None of us have much more common sense. But it would be an awfully dull world."

"Oh, we'd never forget men—even if we could no longer see them. Men are in our blood. We'd remember them even in our vision."

"My heart chooses even at the thought of it. It would be hell on Earth without men. They are romanticists. They provide the poetry, the music, the dreams in life. Women are too practical. Besides, men smell so good—with their woolly clothes, their sweat, and their stinky old pipe smoke."

"It wouldn't be enough for a woman to mother a little girl baby. It wouldn't satisfy her. She wants to mother a real big baby—a man."

### NCO Crack-Ups Studied by Army

Landstuhl, Germany, Sept. 23 (AP)—The U.S. Army in Germany is trying to find out why some career sergeants crack up mentally after 12 to 16 years' service.

Lt. Col. Frederick A. Zehrer of New Britain, Conn., psychology chief at the Army's 2nd General Hospital here, says "an expectedly large proportion" of veteran NCOs (noncommissioned officers) are ending up in psychiatric wards.

He made a 6-month study of 46 sergeants hospitalized for emotional and social maladjustments after years of efficient service. They came to the hospital "incapacitated or functionally inefficient."

"The psychologists emphasize that his findings reflect only the initial phase of a long-range study. Of the sergeants, 70 per cent expressed feelings of insecurity and anxiety in relation to the NCO or officer to whom they were responsible." The survey indicates men who have wives opposed to their military career may develop anxiety and become inefficient during the post-middle years of service.

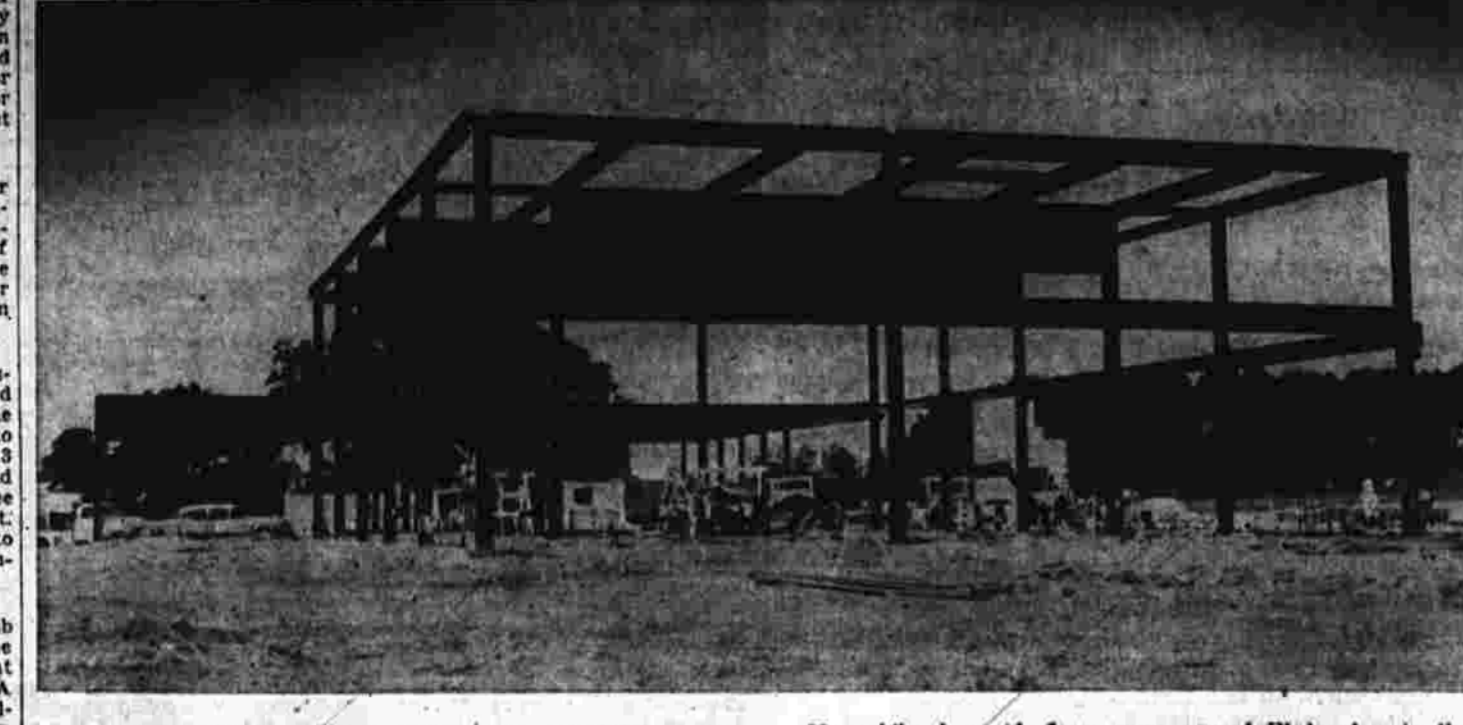
