Year Teaching in France Enjoyed by Miss Heckler

The Cold War may have its disadvantages, but in knowing the world out of point, it is also opening up untold opportunities and not just to the students, who often do not want to go, but to the teachers, who often do not want to go as soon as they get to France.

For Miss Alice Heckler, a left-aim, dark-haired fourth grade teacher at Robertson School, for instance, the present state of the world's uncertainty afforded a year of living in France and travel in Europe.

The tie-in between Miss Heckler's enjoyment and the Cold War is the fact that the military services, with their worldwide commitments, are permitting their men to have their families with them.

In granting this permission, the services have accepted the responsibility of providing schooling—American type—for the service men's children.

Schools have been set up at overseas bases overseas, and American teachers are needed to staff them—and that's where Miss Heckler came in. She applied last year to the Army for a teaching job in France, was accepted, obtained a year's leave of absence, and on Aug. 13, 1954, sailed for Europe and her assignment at an Army dependent school in Fontainebleau.

Miss Heckler isn't the only teacher to take a job teaching overseas. Miss Dorothy Smith of Washington School faculty is now in the Fontainebleau School, while Miss Heckler left last year to teach at the American School in Orleans, France. And Mrs. Mary Lou Clark, a Verplank School teacher, is teaching in Nancy, France. Miss Sarah Jones, a former Manchester teacher who taught at the Hilldale Street School, also has been abroad for several years. After leaving Manchester, she taught in Japan for two years, and then went to Augsburg, Germany, where she is now vice principal of the school.

Bolton, October 7 (Special)—Final plans for the addition to the school should be ready by the end of this month, school building committee chairman Raymond E. Cooper has announced.
