Young men of Manchester and vicinity, between the ages of 17 and 24 years, now have the opportunity to discharge their military obligation established by Congress by enlisting in the Third Grange Co. and its affiliated companies. Col. William Dorey announced today.

The new Reserve Force Act offers an excellent opportunity for young men to continue their schooling or civilian careers with a minimum of interruption for active military service. Men enlisting in the program will serve six months on active duty in this country, receiving special training from selected instructors. Following this tour of duty, they will return to civil life, and will complete their enlistment with the local unit, or other Reserve units. Men attending high school may be deferred from the six months active duty training until they have completed high school. After completing the six months training, they are exempt from the draft.

Col. Dorey emphasized that this program is only available to persons between the ages of 17 and 24. Other Reserve programs are set up for men over 28. He stressed that stipend-draft calls are in prospect for the coming year.

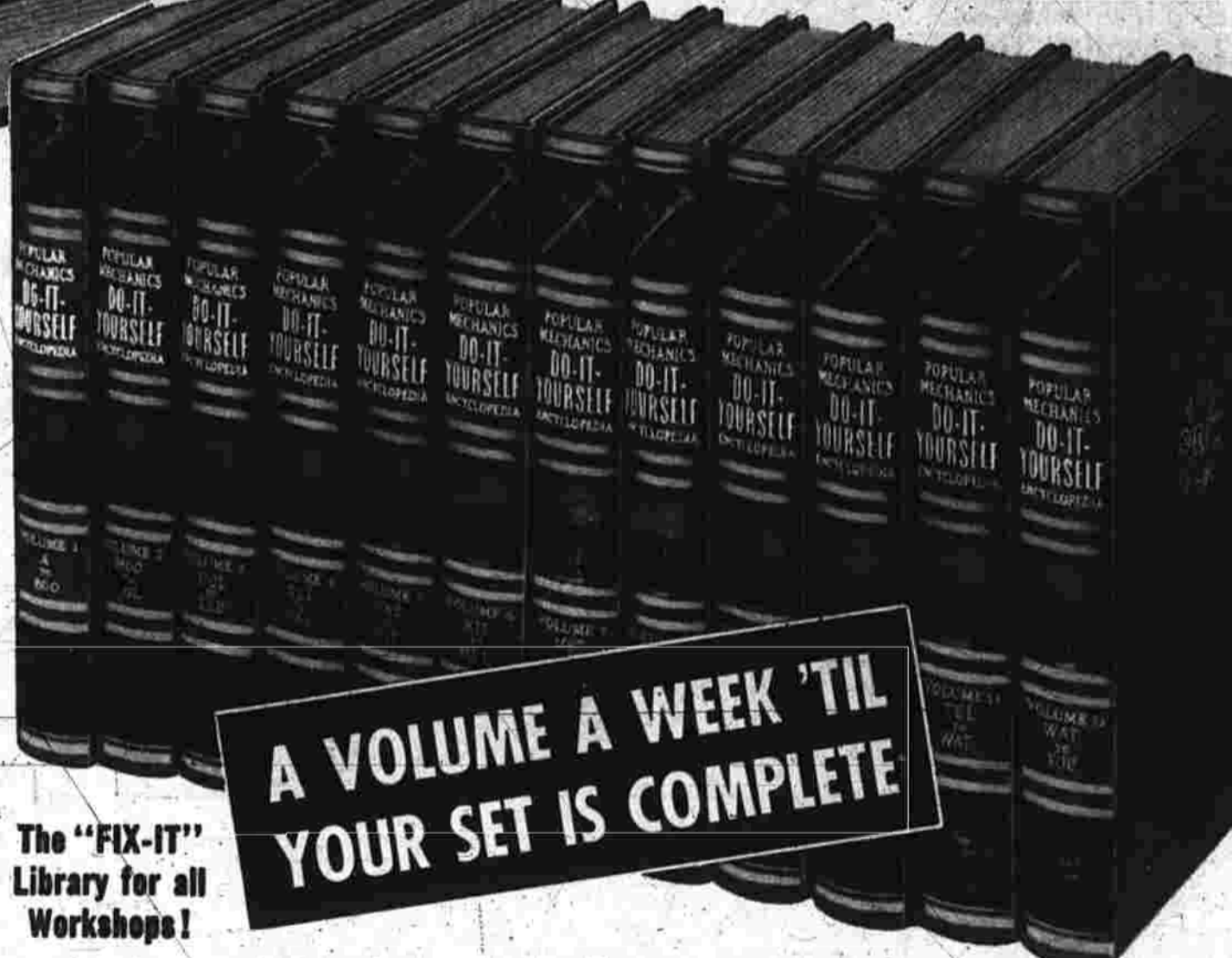

Missing Girl, 13, Located; Slept in Melrose Hayfield

Wilmington, Oct. 12 (Special)—Thirteen-year-old Linda Lou Wagner, missing from her home in Wilmington since Monday night, was found safe in Melrose this morning, about five miles from her home.

She was immediately returned to her parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. Wagner, of Tomahawk, N. J. An all-night search was conducted by State Police and bloodhounds last night in the woods near her home, and this morning following reports that a girl answering her description was seen in East Hartford, police were combing that town.

Linda Lou was found by farmer Walter Hask while mowing a hayfield. Linda Lou had been out all night in the hayfield, and when awakened by the noise of the mowing machine, she ran into a barn.

Hask saw her and took her into his home where she called her mother, State Police Officer Joseph Koss, who took the girl home and gave him the following story: She left home about 2 o'clock yesterday morning, leaving a note to her parents that she was running away. Trooper Koss said the girl gave no reason why she did so. She apparently walked the remainder of Tuesday night and during the day, last night, she said, she slept in the field near Hask's farm. Linda Lou left home after repeatedly talking to her mother, her parents, Mrs. Wagner said she didn't report her daughter's disappearance at once because she felt the girl would return after thinking things over. Nathan Gatchell, principal of the Longley School, where Linda Lou is an eighth grader, said "it was very much amazed to learn of her disappearance. He described her as 'an average student, very stable and well-behaved,' and 'around girl.'
