Welfare Aides Study Problem Of Family Help

Research men went on the trail of this problem in St. Paul, Minn., several years ago. They disclosed that about two-thirds of the tax and charity money spent by the community for health and welfare went to six per cent of the city's families.

"These families had a multiplicity of social, economic, or delinquency problems," according to Dr. Gordon Hatcher, director of the CRA project in Hagerstown.
