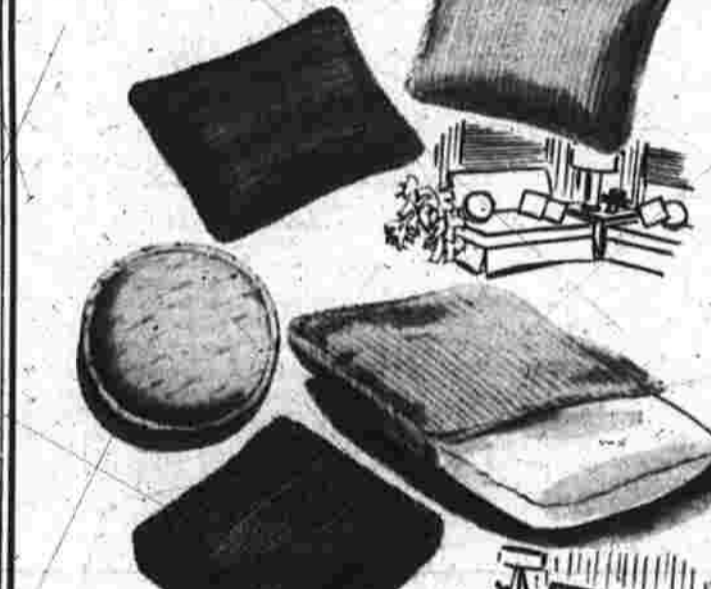

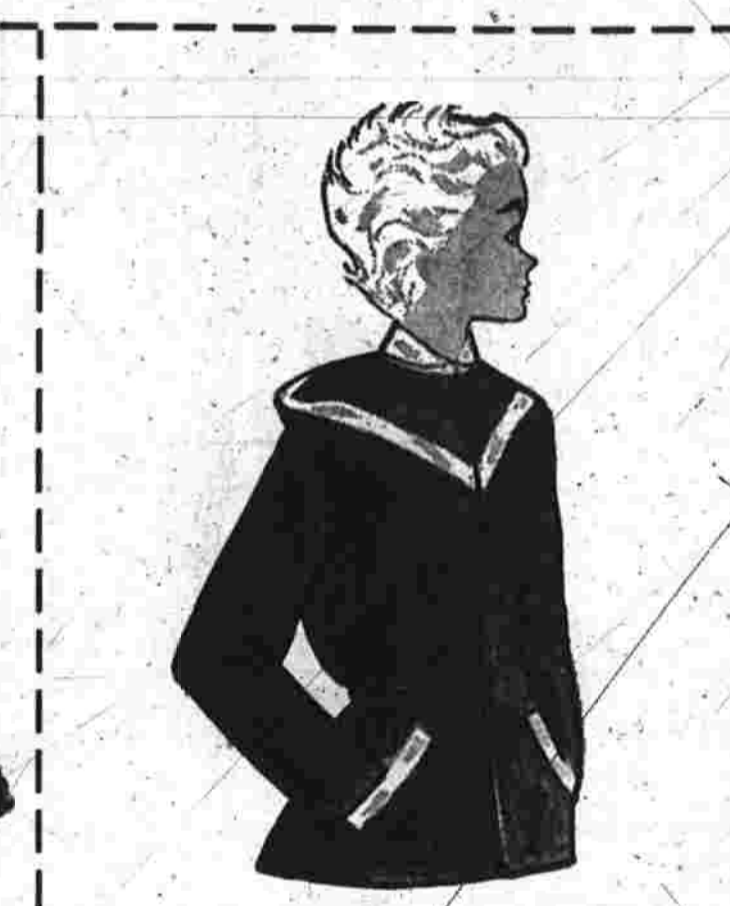

Report Shows Daily Census Hike at MMH

The average daily census at Memorial Hospital increased by approximately 10 per cent during the fiscal year Oct. 1, 1954, through Sept. 30, 1955, hospital officials reported today.

The increase, which was noted in statistics compiled by hospital officials in their annual report for the fiscal year, was not unexpected. The daily average climbed from 138.6 to 151.7.

In other statistics, the hospital reported the greatest number of births ever for one year, with 1,136 deliveries in the maternity ward last year, compared with 1,067 in 1954.
