positions concerning measures of safeguard and supervision so as to insure the freedom of these elections.
The commission will also offer rapidly and will submit its report to the four powers in January 1956.
Dulles told Molotov the present negotiations on German reunification constitute an "aid test" of the new hope which the world gained from last July's summit conference.
If the general agreement of President Eisenhower, Premier Bulganin, Prime Minister Eden and Premier Faure to that time are to mean practical benefits, Dulles said, they must be translated into actual and specific agreements on concrete problems.
Dulles was chairman of today's meeting.
Fifty declared elections in Germany must not be delayed beyond next year, Dulles said, and the length Molotov's argument in previous sessions must now deal with the concrete problems of Germany made up of two rival states, one pro-Western and the other pro-Russian.
Molotov rejected this contention and called on Molotov to let the German government work out its own future.
Dulles based his argument on specific provisions of the summit conference directives to the foreign ministers to deal with German unity and the German government to provide for unifying Germany through free elections.
He said "very considerable" progress had been made in working

But more than two hours of argument yesterday failed to produce any evidence that the beginning of a settlement was in sight.
Dulles handed his statement that the western alliance must be demobilized before Russia will agree to reunification.
The western Big Three reiterated their position that the Big Four should not deal with the reunification of Germany until they have agreed on a common position for future peace in Europe.

club shifted to St. Louis to make up the present "Cardinals" outfit. There, in two years, he won 46 and lost 35, and was shifted to Boston in the American League. There he won 191 while losing 112. He was again back to Cleveland in 1900 for a two and a half-year span. Before going back to Cleveland he pitched for a month and a half in the 1911 campaign. In that last season, he won seven and lost six at the age of 45—he legs, not his arm, causing his retirement at the end of the year. During his 22 years on the mound, he compiled an average of .619 in the victory column, and struck out 2,832 batters. The highest salary he ever drew was \$2,500 a year.

Young had lived at the farm home of his former neighbors, the Benedict family, since 1935, the year after he died.

He is survived by a brother, Lon Young of Trenton, Mo., and a sister, Mrs. Ella Ripley who is in a nursing home at nearby Dover. For many years he made frequent trips to Cleveland to watch the Indians play, but in recent years the number of such jaunts diminished. Last season he was able to attend only one game at Cleveland stadium.

One of his big complaints about baseball as it is played today was "They're always changing pitchers, and that's above the game." Cy's birthday, March 29, for years has been a occasion for friends to come from all over the country to pay him honors. At such times the old pitcher would make a few observations about himself and the game he loved so well.

Shortly after his 88th birthday, Cy complained his eye was failing him and a number of specialists he evaded hadn't been able to provide glasses that would remedy the condition.

"I can still see well enough to spit words, recognize people and walk around by myself," he said. "But change in reading, watching television or watching a ball game are beyond me now."

"I lost around most of the time, but I help with anything that has to be done," like hunting corn, looking after the house, or splitting wood, I do plenty for my kind.
