Hartford, Nov. 15 (P.—A proposed amendment has three provisions intended to repair the new state primary elections law. It may be acted upon by the legislature in the special flood session. The new primary law goes into affect the first of next year.

1. One that spells out the way a minority party can nominate a candidate for governor.

2. One that would permit the State central committees of both major parties to amend the rules without waiting for the next state convention.

3. One that will allow fown committees to change their rules until the next party caucus.
