

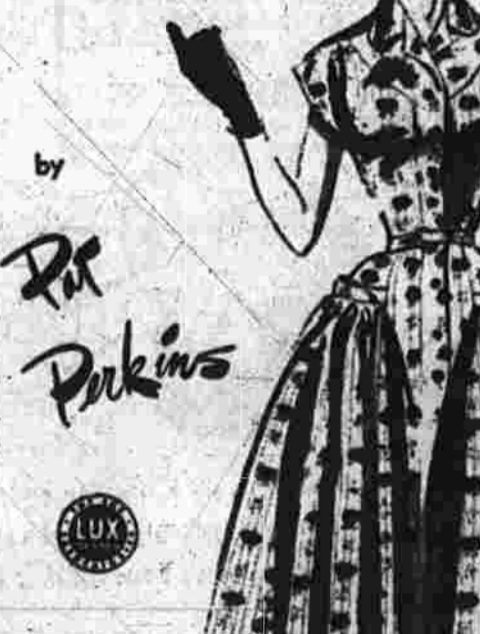

UN Presses To Resolve Seat Issue

United Nations, N. Y., Nov. 25 (AP)—With 12 working days left before its scheduled adjournment, the U.N. Assembly pressed today to break stubborn deadlocks over a disputed Security Council seat and the membership bids of 18 nations.

India Views Stated India and a number of other countries who did not take part in the debate before the 12-nation U.N. Disarmament Commission have indicated they will have plenty to say on the arms question when it reaches the 60-nation Plenary on Nov. 29.

Delegates hoped Arab approval of the measure which broke the French boycott would speed solution of the complex membership question.

The Soviet Union has warned that it would veto all non-Communist applicants if Outer Mongolia or any of the other four Russian-backed candidates failed to make the grade.

U.S. to Abstain The United States has said it would abstain on all five Communist applicants, but had previously insisted that Outer Mongolia would not get the seven alternative votes needed for Council approval.
