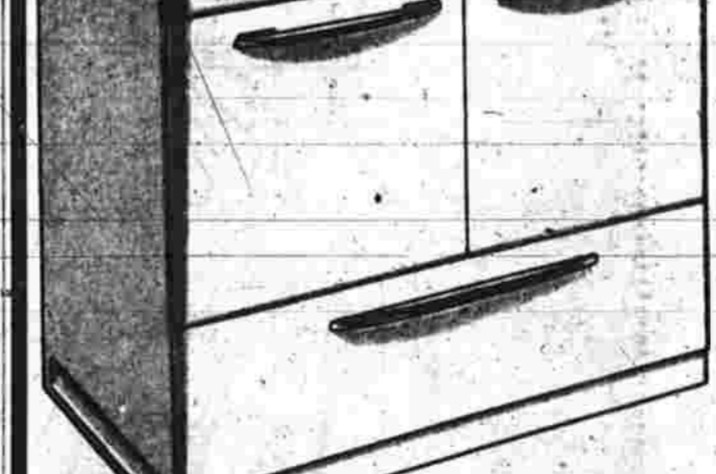

In his decade of rule Peron kept all opposition under tight control. His police jailed Communists, Roberto Ghidini, Communist presidential candidate, was shot in the back during political rioting following last June's unsuccessful revolt against Peron.

But the Communists survived. Argentine in that year's congressional elections they claimed only 100,726 votes, that represented a 42 per cent increase over their claims for the 1951 elections.

Chiboldi recovered, is active as one of the party's top men. His wife, Neustria Palabra, in the 1954 elections to "Peronista" workers who have seen from their own experience that the Communist Party is the only party which defends until the end the interests of the working class.

Muniz says the best assurance that communism hasn't a chance in the type of election now running in Argentina's government.

He asserts provisional president Gen. Pedro Eugenio Aramburu and his collaborators are prepared to act actively and forcefully against extremist threats from either left or right.

Authorities have cracked down on Communist activities. Police using tear gas and fire hoses broke up two-sided rallies, one a "give funeral" on Argentina, the other to mark the anniversary of Russia's Bolshevik revolution. Neither Communist Party members are represented on the national consultative junta, a 20-member panel which advises the Aramburu government.

It continues: "If your Board is interested in purchasing its insurance through this equitable manner, we will proceed and furnish your board with a comprehensive survey of all the requirements that you should need."

"We also propose to furnish the Board of Selectmen with a list of qualified agents who are to share an equal basis. As we pointed out at our recent meeting with your Board representatives, the town of Bolton could save thousands of the premiums it is now paying by purchasing its insurance through a committee to handle its insurance program."

Again we want to take this opportunity of thanking your Board for the meeting of Nov. 9. We trust he can be of service to you. The letter, signed by the four agents who initiated the proposal, also noted that the agents represented a majority of the insurance agents in Bolton.

Radioactive Dishes Puzzle New Mexico Meteor Expert

Albuquerque, Nov. 30 (AP)—Dr. Lincoln LaPaz said for his non-atomic bomb explosion time meal, a Geiger counter on the table and watched it go nuts over his dishes.

Before the day was through, LaPaz, head of the Western world's only institute of meteoritics, at the University of New Mexico, found himself with a disturbed wife telling him to get rid of the dishes.

He also had a "haunting mystery" and theorized that a couple of plate manufacturers may be sitting on a uranium mine.

Orange Glass Held-Cause
What LaPaz discovered while testing a package he had received was that orange glass on his pottery plates was sending out "beta" rays at a rate of 100,000 counts per hour compared to background radioactivity in the air of 30 millirems. In other words, the plates from which he had been eating were radiating, although apparently not dangerously so.

The radioactivity was confined to the orange glass. The pottery itself was not radioactive. In fact, he said, were from two different manufacturers and in each case gave off the same amount of radioactivity.

The orange glass coating, he said, was one-fifth of a millimeter thick. Asked what he thought caused the radioactivity, LaPaz said:

"The only thing I can say is this: I'd like to know where they get the coloring material. I'd sure as heck stake a claim."

LaPaz, who has worked with radioactive materials in the past, mentioned a piece of granite against the plate. Tritium is
