Outer Mongolia UN Bid Seen Embarrassing U.S.

The United States has been backed into an awkward position in the United Nations in the dispute over Outer Mongolia's claim to U.N. membership. The dispute could be part of a process to make the whole Chinese representation question blow up in American faces.

Nationalist China, in the U.N., has claimed by the Chinese Communist, threatens to veto a package deal on the admission of U.N. members because that package includes the Mongolian People's Republic, a Soviet satellite.

U.S. Decides to Abstain

The United States opposed the Mongolian application. But now the United States is in the position of having to try to persuade the Nationalists not to veto in the Security Council. A deal which a majority of United Nations members want to go through. Such use of the veto would be ammunition in the Communist campaign to drive the Nationalists out of the U.N.

The United States got off one shot by deciding to abstain in the vote on Outer Mongolia's application. It got onto another book with the Nationalist Chinese threat.

The government of Chiang Kai-shek recognized the Mongolian People's Republic in 1946, shortly after the Chinese Republic and the Soviet Union signed a treaty of friendship and non-aggression. But

year ago, 85 percent of them (Nomadic herdsmen, it has seven times as many camels and 215 times as many sheep and goats as it has people.

The Soviet long was a target of Russian imperial ambitions in northern Asia. Chiang Kai-shek displayed an ability for nationalist campaigns of internal subversion in northern China. After the Russo-Japanese war in 1905, the Russians agreed with the Japanese on recognizing special Russian privileges in Outer Mongolia. Once entrenched, the Russians favored an independence movement and Communist troops moved in.

Pro-Russian Gains Throne

With the Sun Yat-sen revolution in China in 1911, the Communists prodded Mongolian princes into accepting from China and brought a pro-Russian Mongol to the throne. The new republic of China refused to recognize him. In 1924 the Communists recognized Chinese domination over Outer Mongolia. A move to save Chinese face—but by 1924 invasion.

Some diplomats seem puzzled about the United States' attitude. But it seems possible that Outer Mongolia, once a source of friction between China and both Communist Russia, could well be a pattern itself on the Soviet model. A Soviet-Chinese conference that again between Peking and Moscow.

Cleveland, Washington, D. C., San Francisco, Cincinnati, St. Louis and San Antonio. The "worst states" are New York, Illinois, California, Michigan, District of Columbia, Ohio, Texas, Missouri, New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

Parisian Style Baby Sitting Real Professional Quality

Paris (NEA)—"Operation Two-year," often because they marry young, is proving a fad-year boom to Paris mothers and medical students. The mothers were looking for baby-sitters, a problem that is pretty universal. The medical students were looking for some francs to put in their pockets. So they set up their "feeding-bottle" organization, and today on 24-hour notice they'll provide a baby-sitter with more than average experience, plus some medical know-how to boot.

More than 400 names are already on file at the headquarters of the Medical Students Association, housed in a building donated by the American Friends of France. Most of them are third-year students who have already taken their course in pediatrics. All a mother has to do is state the number and age of her children and any other relevant particulars. Mme. Jennie Richon, social secretary, who is the wife of a fourth-year student and mother of a baby of five, then contacts the student she thinks best suited for the job.

Sitters guaranteed.

For older children she usually sends a second-year student, a fourth-year man for infants. Parents are assured of every guarantee. Student baby-sitters must be enrolled at the Faculty of Medicine, all are insured and the association keeps a detailed file which checks on the capabilities and record.

The fee is 45 cents an hour, plus fares to and from the assignment. Employers take the student home after midnight. The fee is the same for Sundays and holidays as on weekdays.

Recently a mother called for a student who could take care of seven children whose ages ranged from three to 12 while the adults held a family gathering. Another mother always calls for the same student to take care of her twins since they were three months old.

There are polyglot students for parents who speak no French. According to two-year student Jean-Francois Tisot, the most popular jobs are those with Americans. "While most families will leave coffee and fruit, Americans usually tell us to help ourselves to anything we might fancy in the refrigerator, or they leave a cold meal ready."

Most Popular Job

Of all the jobs which medical students have to take in order to pay their way through medical school, baby-sitting is the most popular. On the whole it is less tiring than bill-posting, waiting on table, driving a taxi, disbanding or distributing letters at exhibitions and sometimes even allowing time for studying, provided all quiet on the nursery "front."

It is estimated that of the 8,000 students enrolled at the Faculty of Medicine in Paris 90 per cent have to earn money to see them through their six years of study, plus another three if they specialize. Records show that 22 per cent of students enrolled abandon after two years. Most women students do not go beyond the third

Firm Planning 80-Home Tract

Metropolitan Homes, Inc. of Hartford, has taken an option on approximately 26 acres of land owned by Albert Schendel east of Gardner St. and north and south of the railroad tracks. The tract is being developed for a proposed 80-house development, Wilfred Maxwell, planning administrator, said today.

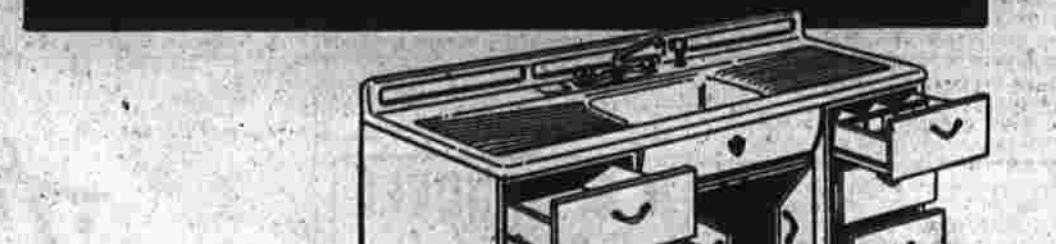

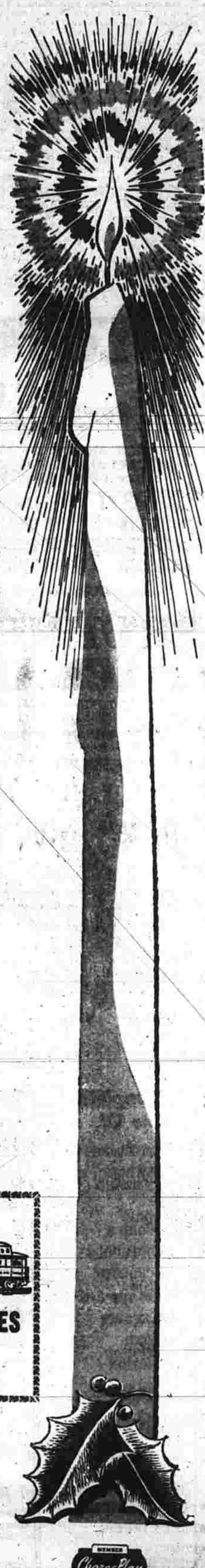

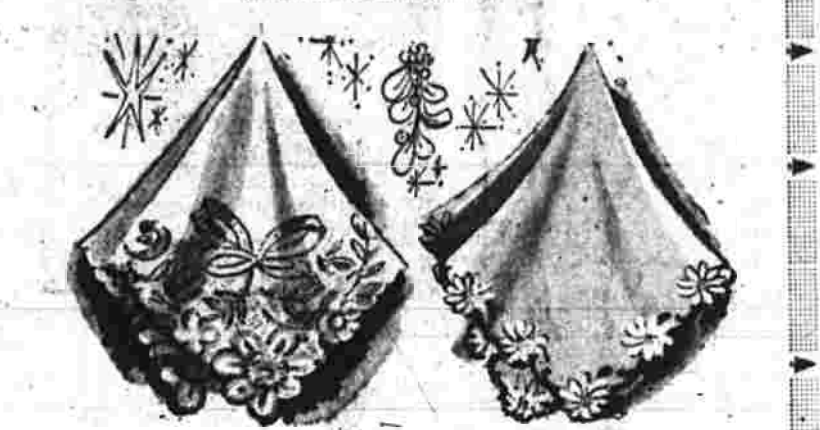
