Hartford, Dec. 9 GP—Industrial wages reached a new high average \$81.37 a week in Connecticut during October, and that month also showed an upturn in manhours lost in labor disputes, the State Labor Department reported today in a stastical survey.

"Connecticut still ranks first in per capita military contract awards. During the period July, 1950, through June, 1955, defense awards allotted to the state totaled \$5.7 billion or 4.7 per cent of all contracts awarded. On a per capita basis, Connecticut's share amounted to \$2.828, a gain of \$116 over the \$2,712 averaged between July 1950 and March 1955. Washington is in accond place with \$2,064 and California is third with \$1,752." The previous high average for industrial wages was \$78, a figure reached in September.






