Ike to Hike Aid Bid to \$5 Billion

Washington, Dec. 17 (AP)—Top administration officials are reported drafting a steeped-up foreign aid request to Congress of nearly \$5 billion for next year—some \$2,200,000,000 more than the legislature voted last session.

Informants said the big new program, partly in answer to Russia's tougher anti-western policies, would be divided up this way: Military assistance—about \$3 billion, triple the amount Congress approved for the present fiscal year which began last July 1.

High ranking administration sources who disclosed the size of the foreign aid plans acknowledged many Congressmen would be surprised—perhaps shocked—by any move to push foreign aid appropriations that high.

A \$5 billion request, the biggest in four years, would reverse the trend toward less foreign aid spending. Secretary of State Dulles and Foreign Aid Director John B. Hollister had both predicted publicly that next year's foreign aid bill would continue at about the same level as this year—\$2,700,000,000.

Several Congressional leaders said after a foreign aid briefing at the White House Tuesday that they were not so much surprised as they were concerned.

Even that, said some lawmakers, was too high as far as they were concerned. "Foreign aid spending would obviously hurt the budget for a balanced budget and a tax cut."
