Our One Clear Glory

Perhaps Christmas didn't happen at all, the way most of us have been told. The way most of us believe it did.

Even the Bible is wrong, for that matter. If there is any proper record of the Birthday, it comes earlier in the month. Our timing coincides with some pagan festivals, which was brought in, perpetuating the hold and influence of some other religion. So, we Christians moved in on it with symbols and worship of our own, for some of its paganism, substituted some of our meaning.

If the date is wrong, there could be other things which aren't just the way we have been told, just the way we believe them, either. It seems rather extraordinary that we should have such details of the birth, and no details at all on the birth of other remarkable names in ancient history. It seems almost unbelievable that a civilized Roman could have been brought to frantic fear of a child, or that, if one child was taken to Egypt, we should ever hear of that fact. Both the details, and the great gap, in the life which has come to mean so much to the world, inspire skepticism and incredulity.

Why should we have every word from one moment of His life, and no word at all about a long span of years in that same life?

There are scholarly reasons for skepticism, too. We have been taught to believe that the Life which came on earth, this night so many years ago, brought us concepts and teachings which were fresh and new, and which were the Word of God, our own particular God. But many of the same concepts and teachings were present in religions which had flowered thousands of years before that. And the recent discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls has given rise to at least a theory that Christ, whom we suppose to have brought truth from Heaven, may have found that truth rather by spending the missing years of his youth with a sect called the Essenes.

But we do not have to wander even that much outside the recognized Christian fold to realize that many things in the story of Christ are debatable. People, all of whom consider themselves good Christians, and who justify their own particular beliefs on the basis of a common heritage of story, history and knowledge, have widely divergent answers to many important questions. Was this a man, or a God? Was it a virgin birth? What parts of the great legend are authentic, and what parts were invented to serve good theological purposes?

Well, that goes far enough to indicate that we could have quite a time of it, if we set out to dissect the story and the legend. Perhaps, with research enough, and skepticism enough, we could destroy it all, who knows?

Suppose we did. Suppose no presumed "fact" went unchallenged. Suppose we left nothing standing in the way of proof or allegation of divinity. Suppose we eliminated the Wise Men, and the stable, and rationalized the miracles all comfortably out of the way, and, in summary, did away with every thing that might strain our credulity in the slightest. Suppose the legend were all gone, and we had left only that collection of words which we know as the Sermon on the Mount, we should know, who said them, or where, or how we got them.

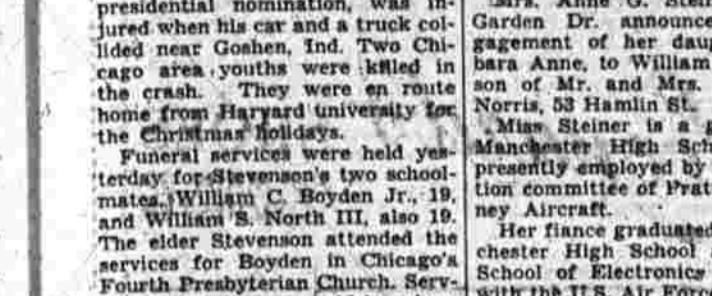

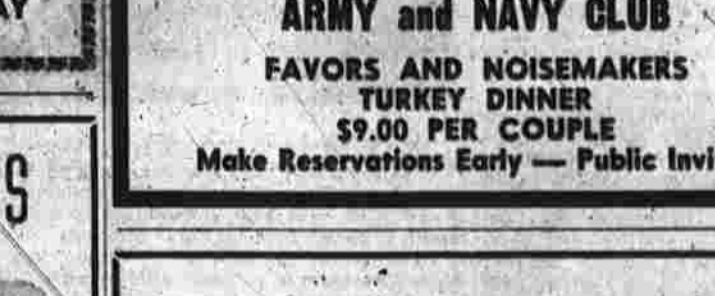
