For Miss Lucy herself, the historic day had an intimate meaning. She said it was "a great personal victory."

The racial barrier remained intact, however, at another school in another state. Three Negro students sought to enter Memphis State College at Memphis, Tenn., but were refused. College officials told them they had failed to pass aptitude tests.

The tests are required under a "segregation system" which admits applicants as graduates with a "B" average or better from a fully accredited college. The Memphis Negro applicants, Minor Dandridge, and the state's first Negro graduate work at LeMoyne College at Memphis, but that he had not decided whether he would again seek admission to Memphis State.
