Hartford, Feb. 22 (AP)—A breakthrough in medical science's long search for an effective insulin which would be taken by mouth may be in the making.

In a letter to doctors in Connecticut, a leading pharmaceutical manufacturer revealed that such a substance is already being tried out clinically with "encouraging" early results.
