Rockville, March 1 (Special)—Statements issued today by the Republicans and Democrats added fuel to the fire of controversy sparked by the GOP move last week to replace Alderman James Doherty, Democrat, with William Schaeffer, Republican, on the Board of Common Council.

Democrats hit back at the Young Democratic Club of Rockville, Vt., which issued a statement by Mayor Olson that he was breaking a tie to pass the motion leading to the replacement of Doherty by Schaeffer. The Young Democratic Club of Rockville decried the statement as "a vulgar and dictatorial maneuver which Mayor Olson was willing to force upon the people of Rockville."

On the other hand, there is an on-the-record statement of the other committee established by Mayor Olson, the Citizens' Committee for the Replacement of James Doherty. This group, which has a membership of 100, has issued a statement which is a far cry from the statement of the Young Democratic Club.
