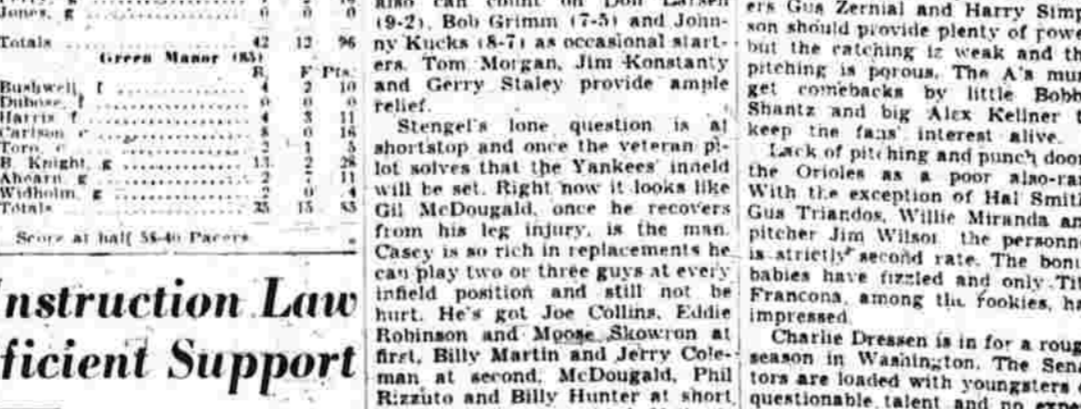

Hospital Receives Portion of Grant

A check for \$40,000, out of a grant earmarked for Manchester Memorial Hospital as its share of the \$500 million Ford Foundation gift to private and non-profit institutions, has been received at the local hospital.

The checks mailed yesterday are the first payments on the operation of the Ford Foundation's grant. At the time, the trustees allocated \$200 million to hospitals, \$100 million to private colleges and universities to help raise teachers' salaries, and \$300 million to medical schools to strengthen instruction.

Other institutions to benefit from which checks have been distributed include: Milford Hospital, \$15,000; New Britain Memorial Hospital, \$25,000; Norwalk Hospital, \$40,000; Sharon Hospital, \$15,000; St. Joseph Hospital, \$27,000; Gaylord's Farm Sanatorium, \$23,000; and St. Mary's Hospital of Waterbury, \$97,000.

According to Dr. Rowan Gilmer Jr., president of the Ford Foundation, more than 1,700 checks, totaling \$27,748,000 have been mailed to over 1,000 of the 3,000 hospitals eligible in the 48 states, the District of Columbia and the territories of Alaska and Hawaii and Puerto Rico.

On the basis of this information, the local hospital is one of the first to be paid. By the end of July, 91 of the hospitals will have received payment. By the end of the year, 900 hospitals will have received payment. The balance of the amount will be paid in 1957.
