Bolton School Budget Hits \$177,784; Salaries, Tuition Cause Jump

Bolton, July 18 (Special)—The Board of Education will submit a budget request to the Board of Finance totaling \$177,784 for the next fiscal year.

The budget was approved at a meeting of the education group this week. The request is \$4,028.44 higher than the current appropriation.

The budget anticipates 88 high school pupils this coming year at a tuition rate of \$475, an increase of \$150 over the current rate.

Brioni Parley May Bolster Neutral Aims

New Delhi, July 18 (AP)—One school among Indian observers believes tomorrow's meeting of the world's three leading neutralists will materially strengthen the creed of nonalignment in this part of the world.

Another group insists the greatest result of the meeting of Prime Minister Nehru, President Nasser and President Tito on the Yugoslav island will be the improving of the positions of the three national leaders in their home countries.

Nehru likely will welcome the meeting as a means of testing Tito after his Moscow visit, confirm Nehru's own view that the new Soviet policy is friendly and directed toward peace.

India's newspapers and Indian officials are giving full attention to the Brioni conference. Despite Nehru's protests that it is really "a quite incidental meeting," Indians who know about the meeting are inclined to rate it more highly.

Nehru Seen Standing Alone

But officials here insist that Nehru has no intention of joining Yugoslavia and Egypt in any sort of "neutrality bloc" or third force, sponsoring nonalignment. Nehru has frequently rejected the idea of such a move, holding that establishment of any formal organization for nonalignment would defeat the very purpose of neutrality.

Nevertheless, Indian observers expect the three leaders to spend plenty of time talking nonalignment. They believe that from these discussions will come a new strength for the three participants at home, if not outside.

Algeria is also a certain subject for discussion. Nehru and Nasser already are fully out of for an independent Algeria, something France refuses to concede.

Indian officials are reluctant to discuss Brioni. For one thing they have received no briefing from Nehru himself on how to "play" the conference. Widespread public opinion seldom develops in India until the Prime Minister gives some guiding signal.

Tito Popular in India

Tito enjoys considerable popularity here. His pronouncements on world affairs coincide with those of Nehru, and his fight for an independent Yugoslavia won him friends. He toured India for a month more than a year ago.

There is considerable opinion evidence here at the idea of rushing into any strong India-Egyptian axis. A number of Indian newspapers have criticized the apparent lack of freedom in the recent Egyptian elections, in which Nasser was the only candidate.

Regardless of his hostilities, the Brioni conference and subsequent Nehru-Nasser meeting in Cairo almost certainly will bring Hindu India and Moslem Egypt closer together.
