Major, Minor Surgery At Hospital Increases

(Editor's note: This is the seventh of a series of articles published by The Manchester Herald as a public service to give readers a better understanding of hospital practice in general and Manchester Memorial Hospital in particular.)

In 1955, Manchester Memorial Hospital's first full year of service to the community, 420 surgical operations were performed. Since then, the number has grown steadily. Within the short time span of the last five years alone, there has been an increase of more than 70 per cent in the number of major operations. At the end of 1955, the annual total of major and minor operations performed reached almost 4,000.

Why so many more operations today? First of all, many diseases, about which little or nothing could be done only 10 or 15 years ago, today can be effectively treated by newly developed operating procedures. Recently, whereas people used to be afraid of operations, they no longer fear them, because techniques have been evolved which assure each patient maximum safety in all three phases of surgery: before, during and after.

In a recent interview, Dr. David M. Caldwell, chief of surgery and gynecology at Manchester Memorial Hospital since 1929, reflected the opinion of other surgeons when he explained the reasons for this extension and greater safety of surgery. The achievements, he said, are the result of teamwork by surgeons, doctors and other scientists in almost every field, including electronics, physics, biochemistry, optics and biology.

"Above all," Dr. Caldwell commented, "such combined effort has made possible the control of shock, pain and infection, without which surgical techniques could not have progressed so rapidly in recent years."

Shock was a little-understood phenomenon in World War I. Many a soldier died from it, not from their wounds. Today, blood and blood plasma are readily available to combat the dangers of shock. Intricate and accurate laboratory procedures give the surgeon vital information about a patient's general condition and his ability to withstand the shock of an operation. Such information is helpful in determining what pre-operative measures would be taken to protect the patient more effectively, decrease risk during surgery and assure speedier recovery afterward.

Furthermore, in many instances

drugs and new antibiotics, such as penicillin, which destroy germs or prevent their multiplication. In the past, the risk of infection frequently forbade surgery, as in the deep-seated body cavities, for example. The discovery of these drugs, however, has made many operations safe which once were attempted only when there was no alternative.

Today's surgical patient also gets better care during the critical period immediately following a major operation. Separate, post-operative recovery rooms are maintained by many hospitals, including Manchester Memorial Hospital, for that purpose.

The patient is taken to the recovery room directly from the operating table. There, doctors and specially trained nurses keep a constant vigil over him, checking his pulse, respiration and blood pressure, until he regains consciousness from his anesthetic sleep. They stand ready with oxygen, blood and other supplies to give the patient emergency care if it is needed.

With so much emphasis on the valuable contributions that other sciences and specialists have made to the safety and extension of surgery, one might think that the surgeon's skill is the least important prerequisite for a successful operation.

Nothing could be further from the truth. Although the resources of many sciences are available to him as a moment's notice, in the final analysis it is the surgeon's ability, born of long years of study, which ensures the success of an operation. Without the sure hand of his trained fingers, there would be no surgery.

Practically all operations, except for the most minor surgery, can be performed only in a hospital setting where the joint effort of a variety of highly trained specialists and the use of elaborate equipment.

The steady increase in the safety, number and range of operations is one of the reasons why Manchester Memorial Hospital, like hospitals elsewhere, is overcrowded most of the time. As more and more patients were able to be treated surgically, the facilities of the hospital, which were built for the community's needs of several years ago, became strained to the limit of their capacity.

Such overcrowding is reflected in the long list of persons waiting for admission to the hospital. During the past year, the number has ranged from 170 to 190 non-emergency patients. Many of them have to wait several weeks before they can even be put on the operating schedule.

Manchester Memorial Hospital is fast approaching the time when expansion of its present facilities will have to be undertaken, if it is to continue its tradition of advancing the community's demand for the best and most up-to-date care in medicine and surgery.

Milford Woman Killed in Crash

Stratford, Aug. 7 (AP)—An automobile-truck collision on U.S. Rt. No. 1 last night proved fatal to the driver of the car, Mrs. Sally Sedov, 52, of Milford.

She died early today in a Bridgeport Hospital.

It was Stratford's second traffic fatality this year, and also the second one in four days. A child on a tricycle was killed by a delivery truck Friday.

Police identified the driver of the van-type garment truck involved in last night's collision as Louis Ruggiero, 42, of 785 Elbert Lane, Brooklyn, N. Y. He was booked on a charge of operating a motor vehicle so as to cause loss of life and held in \$1,000 bail.

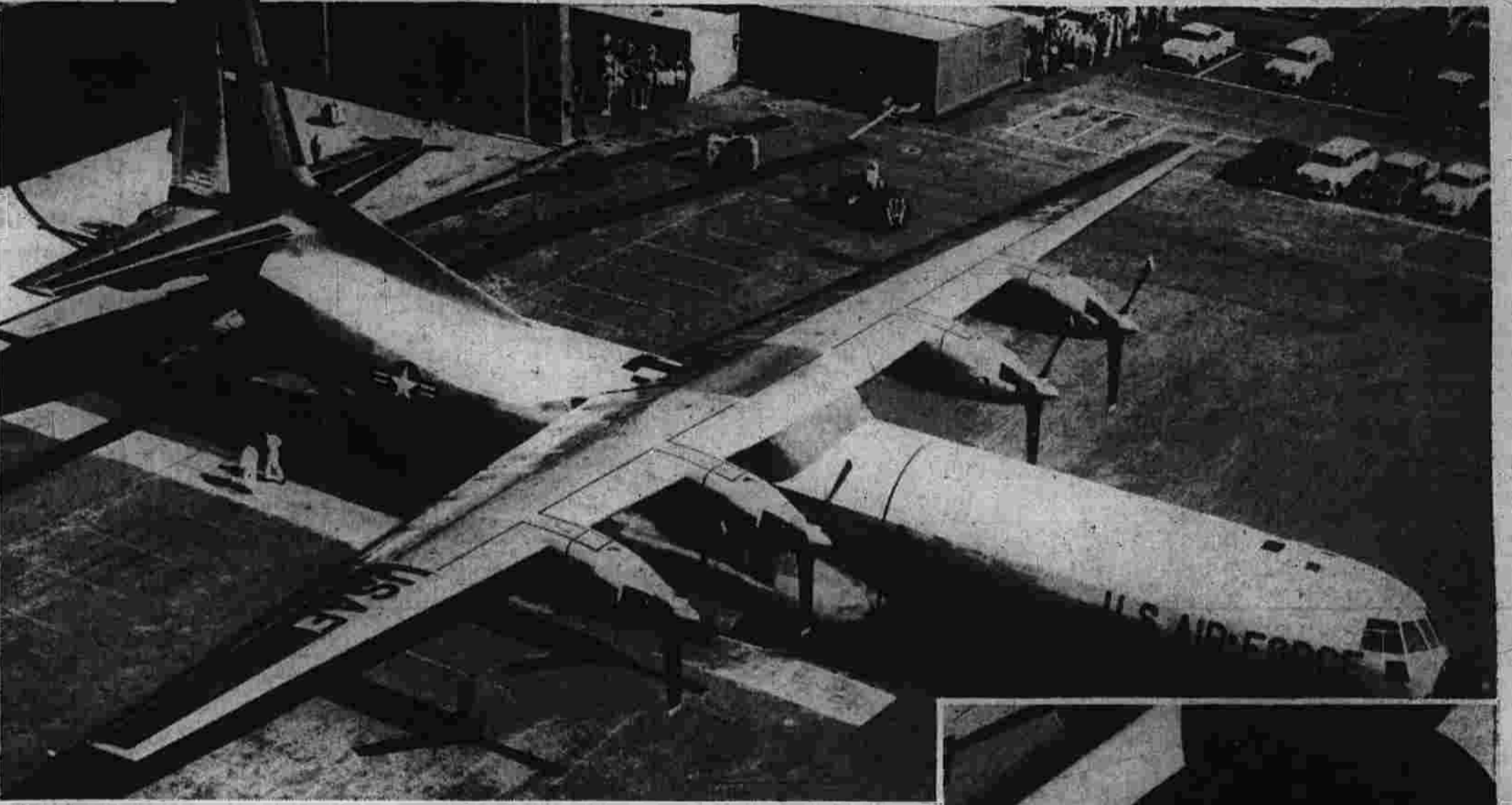
The Navy confirmed three days after the sea tragedy that the six ships from Newport were unaware of the collision until four hours later.

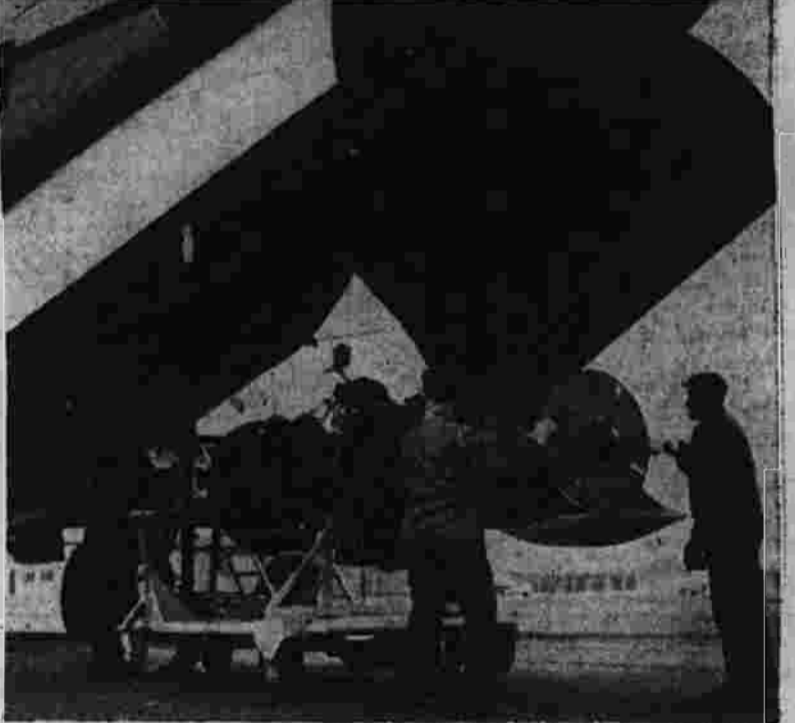

HARTFORD-MADE TURBOPROP ENGINES POWER GIANT NEW CARGO PLANES

The Air Force's newest cargo plane, the giant Douglas C-133A, is powered by T-34 turboprop engines made in East Hartford by Pratt & Whitney Aircraft. The C-133A is the first transport designed and built to fly with powerful T-34 engines, which develop 6,000 horsepower each.

These T-34 engines, which are gas turbines driving propellers, help the C-133A carry twice the normal payload of the C-124 Globemaster, previously the biggest production transport. Deliveries of the C-133A to the Military Air Transport Service (MATS) will start this year.

The T-34 turboprop is already flying in Boeing and Lockheed transports and has set records on world routes of the Military Air Transport Service. These include a 4 hour, 13 minute flight from Newfoundland to Scotland, and distance records for turboprop-powered flights to Germany and Japan. MATS has reported that T-34 engines have required considerably less maintenance than that required for other large transport engines in common use.

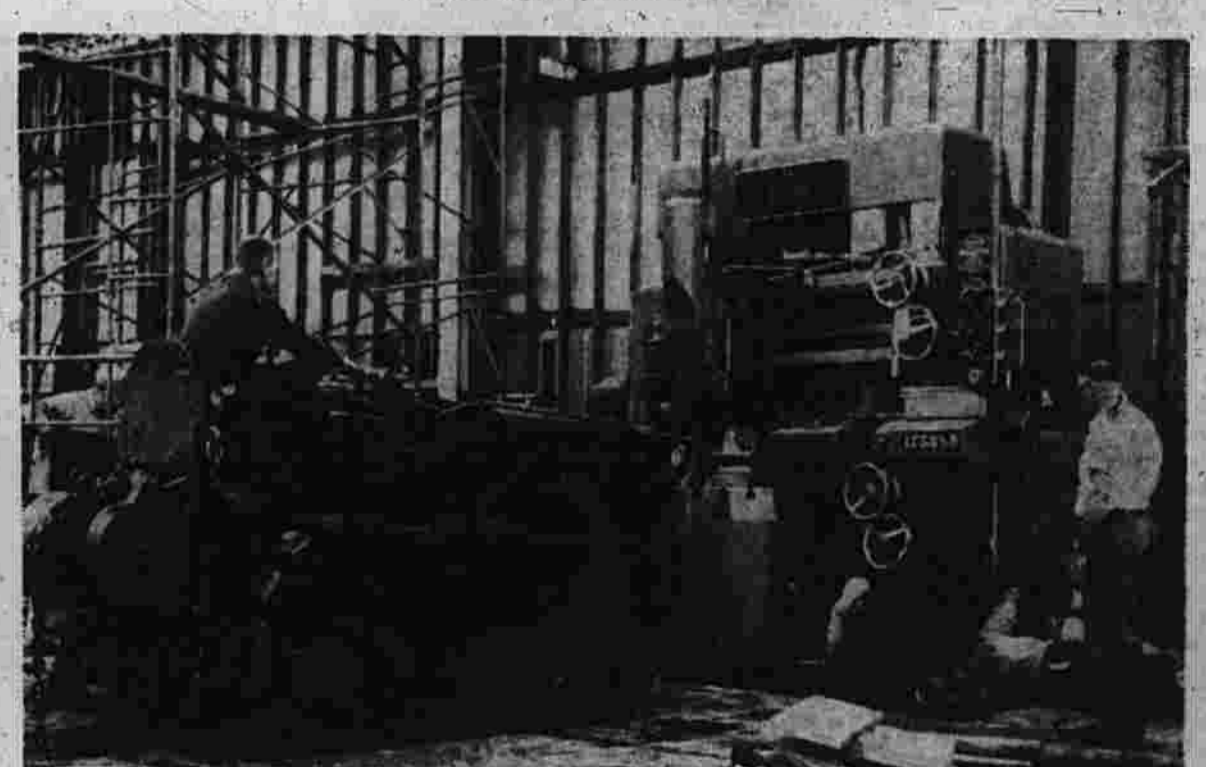
