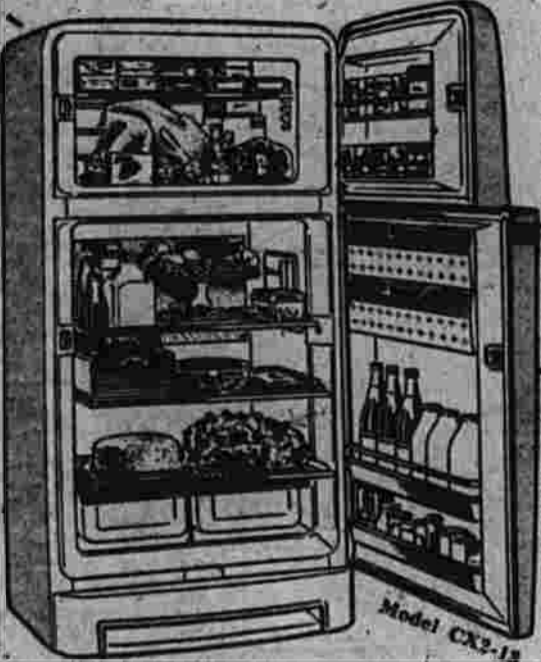

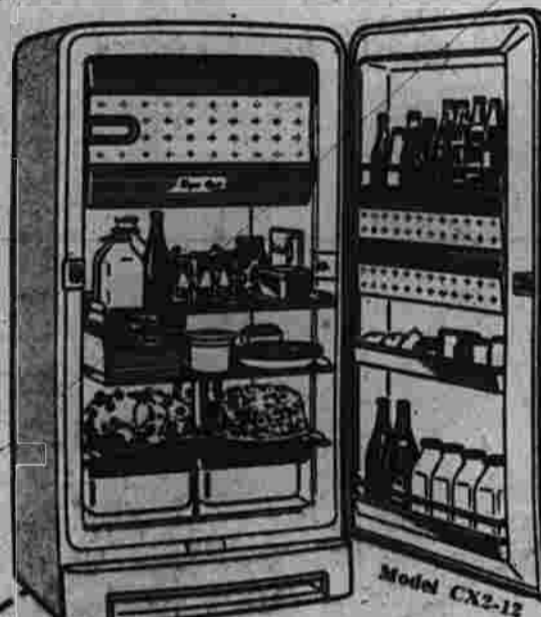

Ag Again Announces Eisenhower, Nixon; Campaign on His Record

Both Set to Accept In Speeches Tonight

San Francisco, Aug. 23 (AP)—President Eisenhower goes before the Republican national convention tonight to accept nomination for a second term and put his administration's record on the line in the campaign against the Democrats.

Fortified by a unanimous vote of widely cheering delegates in his reelection bid, Eisenhower is scheduled to go to the Cow Palace rostrum and before a nationwide radio-television audience just after the convention hears Vice President Nixon who will return here from Whittier, Calif., where his father is critically ill.

Nixon also won renomination unanimously at yesterday's session. He will be the keynote speaker at the final session today of the Republican national convention.

Introduction of Representative and Senator. Address by Vice President Nixon may be skipped since Nixon may decide to stay at his father's bedside at Whittier, Calif.

Never Answered Criticism. Eisenhower told his news conference yesterday he has "never answered criticism in my life and I don't feel the opposition attack will be anything 'but rebound upon the people who make it."

Rockville Olson-Rady Study Defended By Group in Six-Point Stand

Rockville, Aug. 23 (Special)—The Olson-Rady Committee which has come out in favor of establishing two separate school districts in Rockville, today issued a statement defending its stand against positions taken by other groups in the community.

In the 6-point statement the committee said:

1. Consolidation was abandoned by the study committee on advice of competent counsel as impractical because it would require several years of litigation and approval by the State Legislature before it could be effected.
2. The O-R committee suggested in its original report the creation of separate boards of finance for each school district. Rockville already has a finance board, it merely means that tax problems associated with the acceptance of a separate school district would be the responsibility of the existing finance board.
3. Critics of the two-school district report have claimed a lack of consideration for the "human factor." It is urgently recommended that the entire report be read to see how thoroughly the human factor has been considered. Critics have quoted only portions of the report and have thereby presented an untrue picture.
4. Seymour E. Lavitt, proponent of consolidation of town and city, stated that the Olson-Rady study lost 800 students. The figures Lavitt used were taken from the School Study Committee and the School Building Committee report which claimed we would need a 3,000-seat high school by 1960. This report also stated that there would be 1,022 students in 1956. We find, however, by actual fact that there were only 503 high school students for 1956.
5. At a meeting of Rockville Rotary Club Aug. 12, an educator stated there would be an approximate 20 per cent drop in a 4-year high school period. This is borne out by the above figures (1,022 to 803, or 21.4 per cent dropping).
6. Comparing a figure in 1945 showing 238 students in the Olson-Rady report, 20 per cent drop would leave 194 students. However, on the 6-3 plan as now proposed by the Board of Education, the freshman class must be deducted from the 118 student body, leaving 525 students in a combination city and town high school for the year 1960. Certainly this does not indicate an immediate need for a \$3 million, 2,000 student high school.

Bolton Lake Front Owners Shocked Over Lake Drainage Problem

Bolton, Aug. 23 (Special)—Lake investigations at the scene bring from property owners are in a state of shock today following the announcement that the town will be unable to lower the level of Bolton lake as planned.

The Fish and Game Department announced yesterday that new vandalism at the "hook" keyway for the dam gate prevents it from dropping the level of the lake about three feet in order that residents might repair their sea-walls.

The property owners were weary of the never-ending succession of summer weekends spent wading in the water replacing stones in walls that had weakened under the washing of choppy water and the grinding and showing of water in. Last spring they won a campaign to have the water level dropped a few feet for two weeks in September, to allow proper repairs.

A canvass of the town of Bolton in particular today revealed the magnitude of their disappointment at the "bad news." At least two people have hired contractors to do a job they hoped would be permanent, another has piles of stone and concrete on hand for the low water period and another man has arranged his two week vacation to coincide with the State's promise. Second Coal Mine Fire Hits Belgium

Martine, Belgium, Aug. 23 (AP)—Belgium had her second coal mine fire in 15 days today. Unlike the first which claimed 263 lives, the brief blaze caused no casualties.

Today's fire broke out in a pumping station 2,920 feet below the surface at the St. Charles mine south of Charleroi. A short time later a mine official said the blaze was under control and that 48 men had been brought safely to the surface.

The mine lies only a few miles from the Bois du Casier site, where 263 miners perished after being trapped in the Aug. 8 blaze. Earthquake estimates had put the dead at 260.

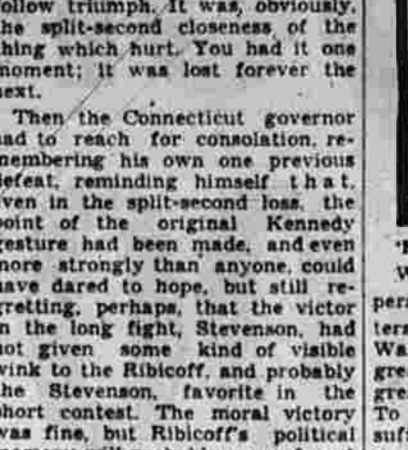
