Ke Says Goal 'Peace for All Time' Kidnaper Directs Police to Dead Body of Weinberger Baby

Minola, N.Y., Aug. 24 (AP)—A debt-ridden cab driver, seized as the kidnaper of the Weinberger baby, today directed police to the lonely, overgrown spot where the dead child lay—abandoned there in panic. The infant's decayed body was found beneath a tangle of honeysuckle vines and leaves apparently swept over it by the wind in the 51 days since the little boy was taken.

Heat Bothered Ike On Speaker's Stand. President Eisenhower, 73, reportedly was bothered by the heat and the speaker's stand at the White House today. He was asked by newsmen whether he had had a hard day. "As a matter of fact, that last shower," he started to say and broke off. "It was a relief," he said. "Then he added, 'That stand wasn't made for handling papers. Eisenhower read his acceptance speech from a typewritten text whose pages seemed to keep slipping. "When I'm here," Eisenhower said as he mounted the train steps. "It was not up there."

Labels Republicans 'Party of the Future' (San Francisco, Aug. 24 (AP)—President Eisenhower fixed "peace for all time" as the goal of the Republican "party of the future" in accepting formally its nomination for another four years in the White House. "Accepting humbly but confidently" command of the GOP's 1956 campaign for national leadership, Eisenhower told cheering delegates at last night's windy session of the party's annual convention it is not enough to promise "the young men who fight the wars" that there will be "peace in our time."

Cab Driver Admits Asking for Ransom. Tokyo, Aug. 24 (AP)—Search planes and ships today found wreckage and two empty life rafts presumed to be from a U.S. Navy patrol plane which disappeared after radioing it was being attacked off the Red China Coast. First reports of the finding said the wreckage was scattered over the 16-American air-mile area of the Pacific. A four-engine P-4M Mercator the Navy said was on a routine patrol and training mission when it disappeared. Navy officials refused to speculate on the possibility that Communist boats had picked up the plane's crew. The State Department has asked Britain, which has diplomatic relations with the People's Republic of China, to find out if the Reds have any information about the plane and its crew.

Alcorn Named Vice Chairman At Convention. San Francisco, Aug. 24 (AP)—Connecticut's delegation today took home more than they brought to the Republican national convention. The extra was Vice Chairman Alcorn, a post to which Connecticut's Charles M. DeLoach was elected. The honor came to him shortly before the convention opened yesterday to witness the final Communitarian nomination of Dwight D. Eisenhower as President. Alcorn had all he could do in the final convention hours between seeing that all was ready for the President and Vice President Nixon and receiving congratulations.

Adlai Protests Class Splitting Charge by Ike. Liberville, Ill., Aug. 24 (AP)—Adlai Stevenson protested today against what he described as President Eisenhower's "intended group against group." "I am declaring in a statement that it is too bad that the Republican record bears a little resemblance to Eisenhower's description of it," he declared. "There is only one peace now and that is peace for all time," he declared. "He said Eisenhower war had become 'not just tragic, but preposterous.' " "With such weapons," he said, "there can be no victory for any one. Plainly, the objective must be to see that such a war does not occur at all."

Living Costs up Again; 1 1/4 Million Get Pay Hike. Washington, Aug. 24 (AP)—The cost of living jumped seven-tenths of one per cent to 2.9 per cent in the second successive month, sending consumer prices to a record high and bringing wage boosts to 1.4 million workers. Auto workers, under contracts adjusted to living costs, received a 4-cent hourly wage increase. So will some 30,000 electrical workers. Other factory employees, including aircraft, farm equipment and other workers, will gain three-tenths of one per cent. The July index, issued today by the Labor Department's Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), stood at 317 per cent of the 1947-48 average.

TV Buys 725 Pre-1948 Films For \$20 Million. New York, Aug. 24 (AP)—Metro-Goldwyn Mayer pictures today sold a film library of 725 pre-1948 pictures to television stations in a \$20 million sale. The transaction, announced by Charles C. Berry, president in charge of television, was the largest sale of motion picture films since the MGM parent company, means that the film libraries owned by Mr. Chips, Mutiny on the Bounty, and other classic films. 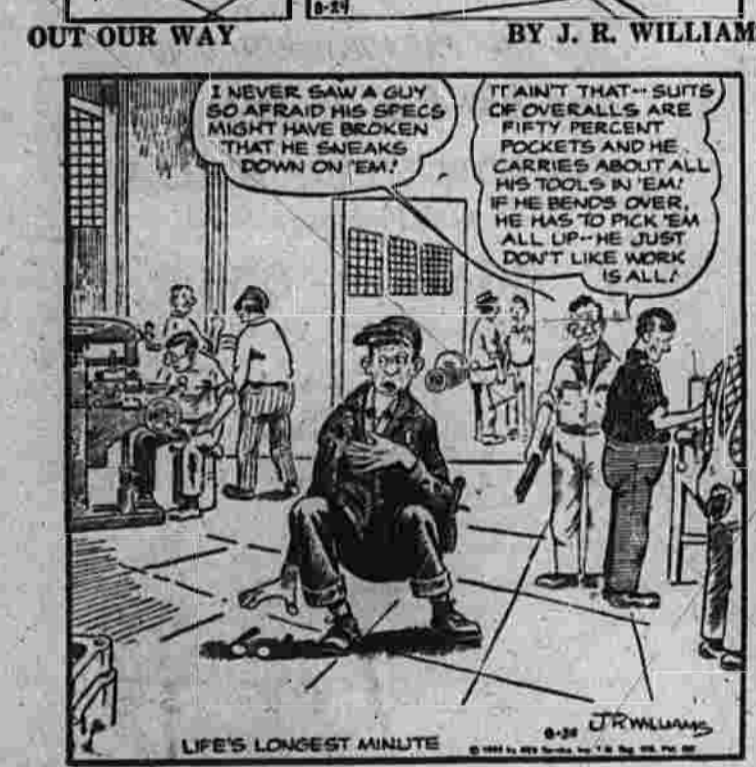
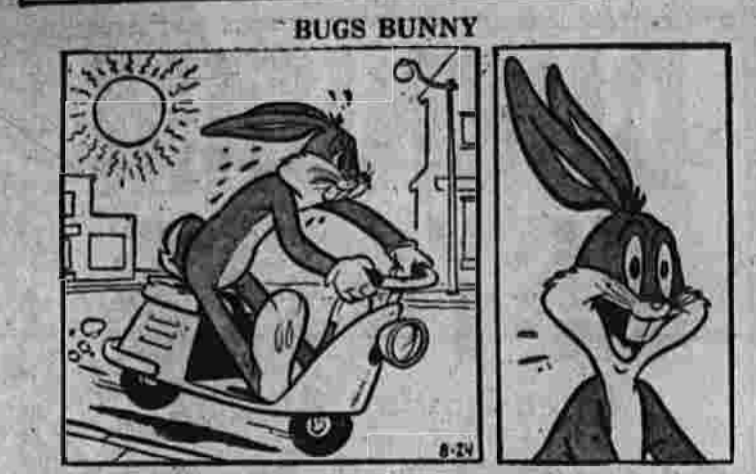
