Whites were seen with rifles in their hands. Ten Negro pupils entered the building and were held in a room. Whites watched them enter but there was no heckling. There also were no pickets for the first time this week.

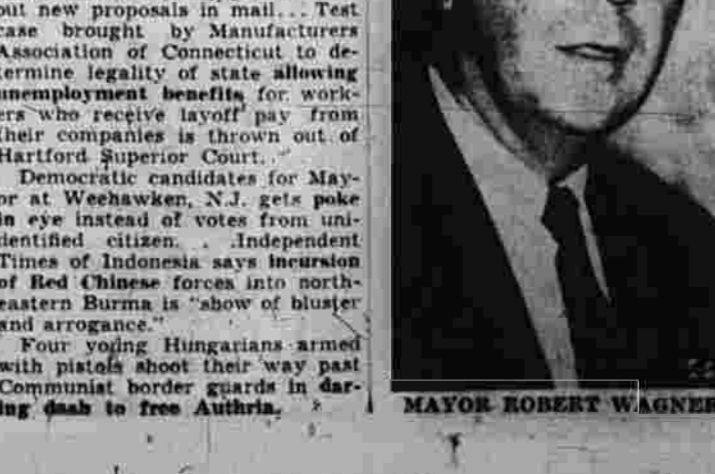

High School Will Open Early To Acquaint Pupils with Plant

The 450 seventh and eighth graders will attend the school which will be opened a day early next week to allow the administrative staff and teachers to acquaint the school's 2,400 pupils for work and play in the new plant.

All of Tuesday and Wednesday will be given over to an orientation program for the junior and senior high school pupils who will be attending the school.

Changes in routine, dictated by the transfer of the high school from Educational Square to the new building on S. Middle Tpk. and Brookfield St., will be explained. Informational material, including a floor map of the huge plant, will be distributed. Guided tours will be conducted.

Then, on Thursday morning, the chief administrative officer will be in the auditorium at 8 o'clock, classes in the 50,000 sq. ft. building will begin for the first time.

In preparation for all of this, the faculty's 105 teachers themselves have been attending meetings at the school since Wednesday. The senior class will meet first, assembling Tuesday morning at 8:30.

The Republican tally will probably stand higher by November, and it is possible the loss may be wiped out by the time the national election rolls around, Hemingway said.

Edward Moriarty, Democratic voter registrar, said there were 6,142 registered with his party before 169 new Democratic voters were made last Saturday. This brings the new total of registered Democrats to 6,311.

Hemingway said he and Moriarty estimate there are about 4,000 registered independents, but no accurate count of these voters has been made.
