With New High School Plant

The new Manchester High School, 400 feet long and 100 feet wide, was dedicated yesterday with a first time yesterday with students and teachers.

Jews throughout the world welcome the start of their Holy Days at sunset today with worship services and efforts at spiritual inventory.

The Holy Days, which begin with Rosh Hashonah, the New Year, end in 10 days with Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, when Jews fast for 24 hours and offer prayers for divine forgiveness for faults and weaknesses.

The 10-day period is devoted to religious self-examination. Rosh Hashonah, which this year marks the start of the year 5717 on the Jewish calendar, is observed for two days and is devoted to prayers of penitence, readings stressing the theme of man's ability to improve, and hymns of aspiration and thanksgiving.

During the services, the shofar, or ram's horn which is associated with great moments in Jewish history, is sounded as a call to conscience. It symbolizes the faith of Abraham, the first Hebrew patriarch, and of his surrender to the will of God.

The following services will be held at Temple Beth Shalom during the two days of Rosh Hashonah: Thursday and Friday, 8 a.m. morning service; 9:15 a.m. Scripture Reading; 10 a.m. Sounding of the Shofar; 10:30 p.m. Evening Service.

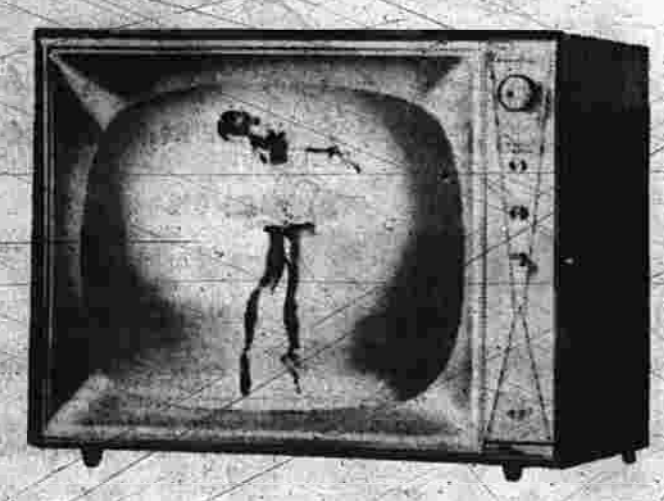

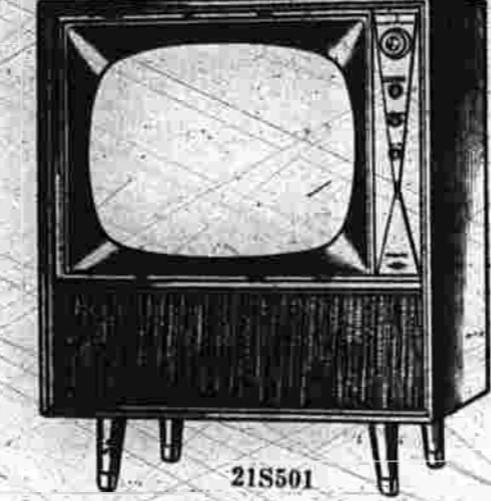

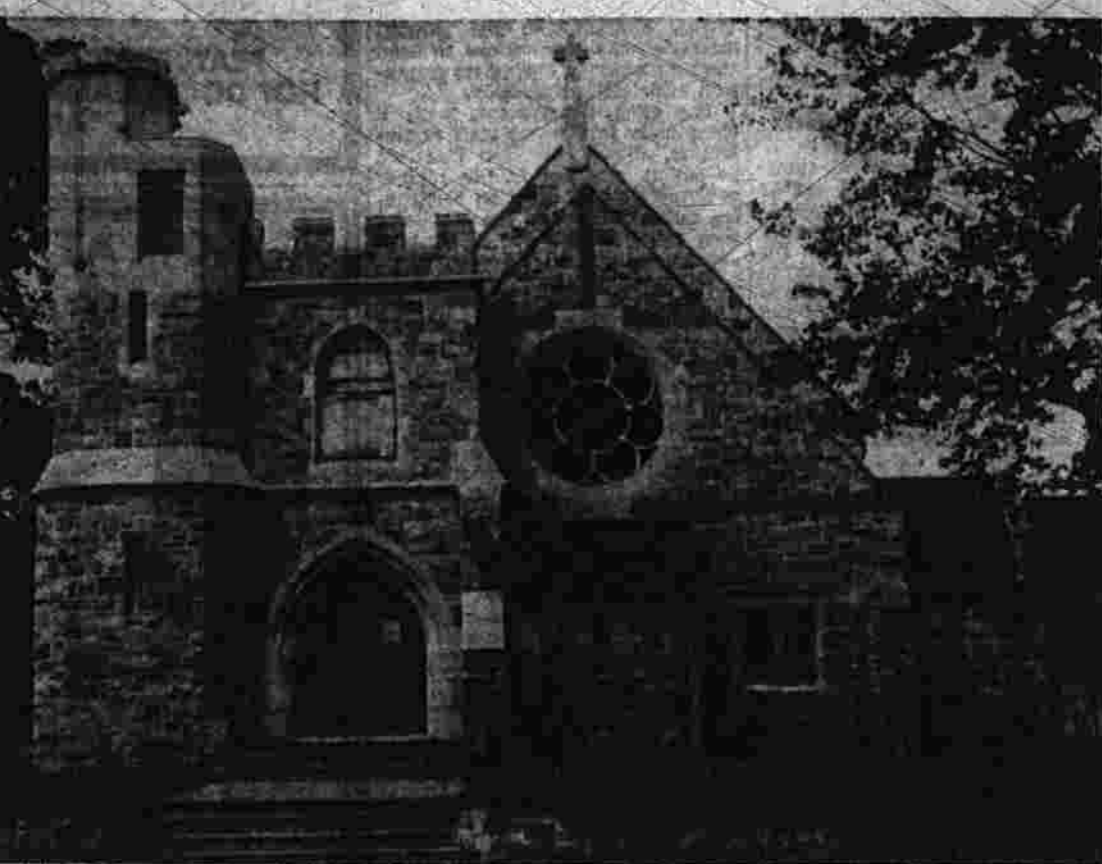
