Another British aircraft carrier, the Royal Navy's 20,000-ton carrier Albion was ordered to sail tomorrow for the eastern Mediterranean.

Lloyd met with the Scandinavian ambassadors this morning. The foreign ministers of Sweden, Denmark and Norway—among the nations expected to join the users' association—are conferring today in Stockholm. After talks with the Scandinavian envoys, Lloyd met with representatives of the Baghdad Pact countries—Iraq, Turkey and Pakistan.

The Middle East situation was still regarded as grave.

The Eden government told Parliament that it was "impractical" to meet in view of the Suez crisis. Britain and France are building up forces on the vital Suez Canal island only a springboard distance from Egypt. These forces are being held in readiness with the aim of protecting the canal and preventing a possible break-out.

Eden got a vote of confidence from Parliament last night on his Suez policies and pushed ahead with plans to set up a canal users' association to handle the passage of ships through the waterway.

The Prime Minister refused to bow to opposition. Labor Party demands for an unconditional pledge to use force without regard to circumstances allowed—in other words, if you like, except in an emergency—to refer to the British to the U.N. Security Council.

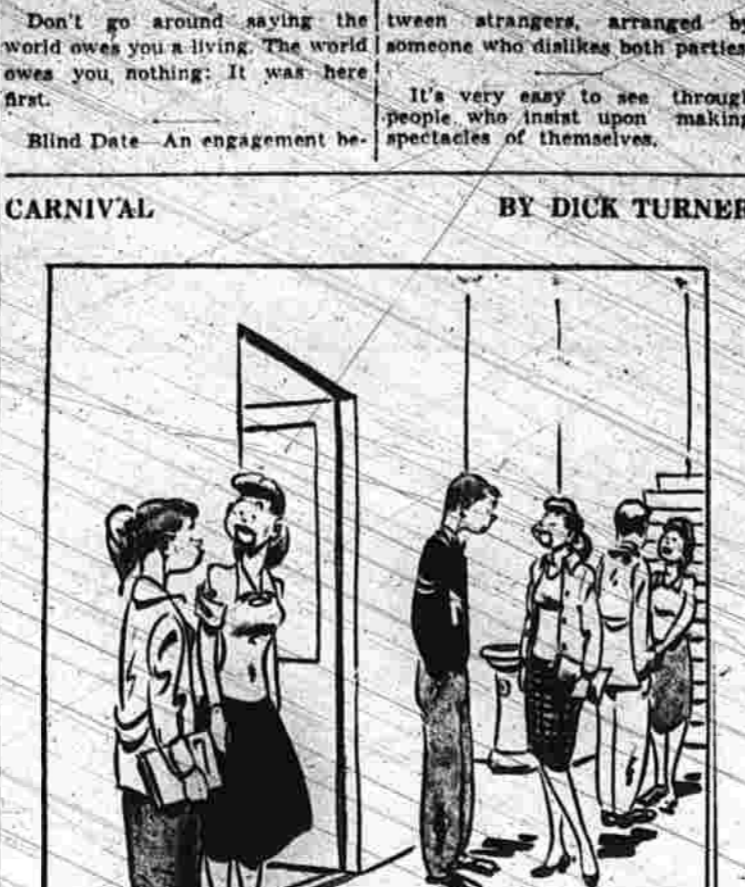

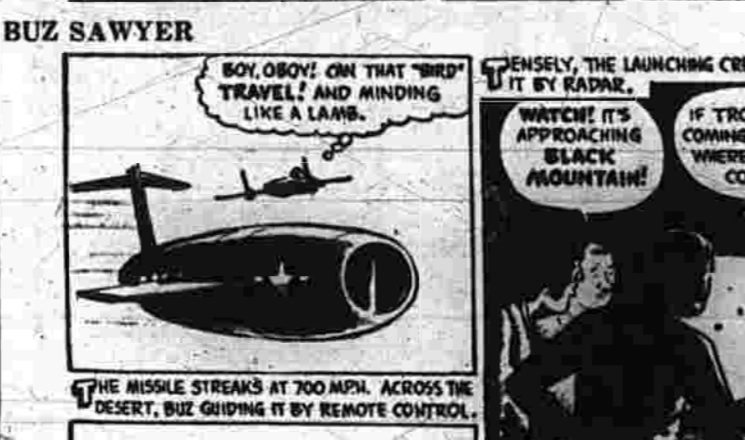
