



Hormone Creams Are Being Une By Edwin P. Jordan, M.D. Written for NEA Service A recurring question-and one

which is of interest to vast num bers of women deals with the us Q When a woman is 52 ar past the menopause, is it danger ous in any way to use hormon creams containing natural estro gens? I have heard that while they do bring back youthful sof ness and firmness to the skin, th can cause cancer. What is you opinion?—Mrs. E. P.

A. When first introduced som physicians felt that hormon creams might possibly stimulate the growth of cancer. This fear does not seem to have been borne out in fact. It should be pointed out, how ever, that there is definite evidence that hormones can be absorbe through the skin. While perha acting on the skin during the post menopausal period, if the amoun of hormones absorbed is too great, other effects can be produced as well. Some of these may not entirely desirable. It is my ow opinion that hormone crean should not be used too profus unless the doctor whom the wome consults from time to time knows about their use. thing about an artificial menopause? 




