Over Five Negro Children Boycott by Whites Cuts School Attendance 75%

had been enrolled in the first, second and third grades Sept. 4, were "perfectly" adjusted. They got along well in the classrooms and on the playgrounds.

West described the sudden protest action as "a stopper in the court proceedings. They are the children of two families. They are Dorothy and Jimmy 'Clay' and Herman, Greg, and William Barnes. There was no immediate comment from their parents.

The Negro students previously had attended the Henderson County Training School at Pottsville. At Frankfort, the state capital, Martin said a boycott would be called if the school district, State Guard troops were sent to the scene and State Atty. Gen. Jo M. Ferguson said the Negroes should not have been admitted, since no integration program had been announced by the school boards. The Negro students then were turned away.

In an advertisement appearing today in the Henderson County Journal, the local White Citizens Council, organized at a meeting here last Saturday, urged white students to stay away from the 11 white schools in the county and in the city.

Total enrollment of white pupils is about 8,000. The five at Weaverton are the only Negroes attending previously all-white schools in the county. Seven Negro children attend city schools which are integrated only in the first grade.

Warren Sees Plank Copy Of GOP Bill

Republican Rep. Ray Warren said today that the main plank in the Democratic platform is no different from a bill he submitted to the General Assembly last year.

Warren's reference was to the Democratic stand on the office of the town clerk. Pequotria, in two previous planks, argued that the office should be appointive and salaried. The town clerk now runs for election every two years and is paid on a fee basis.

Under the bill he submitted, Warren said, the town clerk would have been appointed—and his salary set—by the general manager. The Democrats do not state in their platform what they should do about the appointment or who should set the salary.

"It's pleasing," Warren said, "that the Democrats should express their confidence in the Republican Party by now endorsing our position in the matter of the town clerk."

The bill submitted by Warren was one of two rival measures the General Assembly had under consideration last year. The other was submitted by local Democrats, and Warren was adopted as the Democratic measure.

Warren's bill passed the Republican-controlled House of Representatives but died in the Democratic Senate after local Democrats expressed their disapproval of it. Local Democratic machinery was then controlled by the town committee, Judge Wesley C. Gray, which was ousted from power in a primary last year.

The Democratic measure, like the Republican, would have put the office on a salary basis, but would have kept it elective. That bill was approved by the Senate but not in the House, where local Republicans were able to exert their influence.
