Hal Boyle He Turned the Ocean Into a Goldfish Bowl

New York—If fish have men, the man they have reason to hate must be a French naval officer named Jacques-Yves Cousteau.

He turned the world's seas into a goldfish bowl by inventing the aqualung in 1942. Since then the ocean in his peep hole has become a privacy than a flagpole utter.

Cousteau, a slender athletic man of 48, is the acknowledged "father of free diving." A sport followed by half a million enthusiasts in America.

Since he put on a face mask and submerged for the first time in 1920, Cousteau has made more than 10,000 dives, including a record descent of 200 feet in 1947.

"But altogether I have probably spent a total of two months under water," he said. "This isn't very much, is it?"

Cousteau has a mild disdain for both aquatic sports and pro-

fessional fishermen who go down to the sea with nets.

"Fishing is a thing I hate," he said positively. "I feel that in 20 years fishing will be prohibited in every sea."

But the fish themselves can take little consolation from this prediction. Cousteau, simply creates presents, day fishing methods as beautiful and destructive.

He would mine the oceans of their mineral wealth, turn them into watery farmlands, in which fish are reared as scientifically as cattle are on dry land now.

"The sea is our greatest resource," he said. "It can sustain double the world's present population."

Cousteau has assembled a staff of 50 specialists to plan and manage his future expeditions.

One of the perils of free diving is nitrogen narcosis, or an "oxygen coma" as it is called. "Magnitude of the Deep. No one is just sure how it operates, but under heavy pressure the nitrogen in the air the diver breathes seems to affect his nerves in the same way alcohol causes intoxication.

Cousteau, who has suffered (or enjoyed) this strange sensation hundreds of times, said:

"It may strike you without

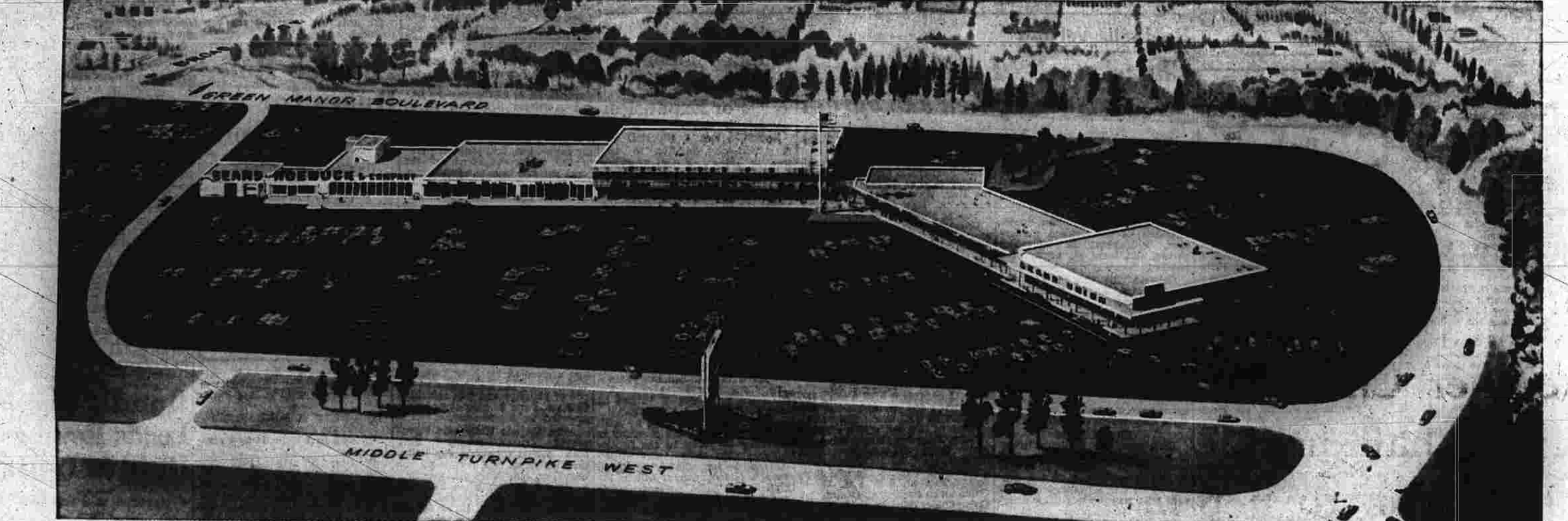
