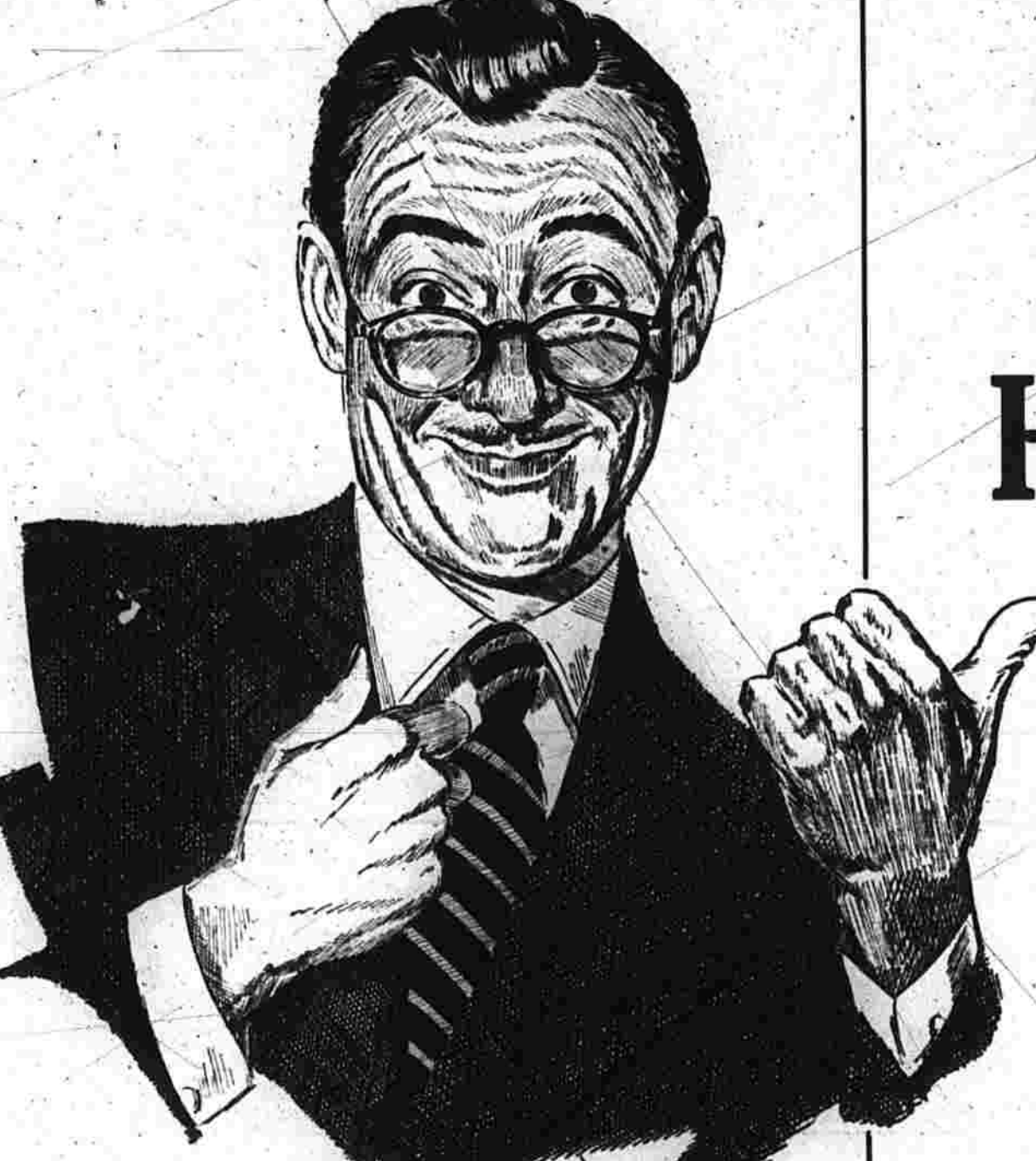

Brings \$75 Fine

Rockville, Oct. 15 (Special)—A 45-year-old Hartford man was fined \$75 in City Court this morning for issuing a bad check in payment for supplies he is using in construction of several houses in Vernon.

Prosecutor Harry M. Luig announced the story in court.

On Aug. 30 Nathan Gatter, a plumbing developer in the area, gave a check for \$500 to James J. Loefer, Williamstown, for cement. The check was returned marked insufficient funds and Loefer gave Gatter 40 ask him for payment.

Loefer agreed to give Gatter two weeks to make good. After the period was up and he did not pay, Loefer brought the matter to court. He also wrote Gatter a letter which he said in court, was never answered. Gatter explained all the money was tied up, but that Loefer had agreed to wait for the money after he got Gatter had discussed it over the telephone.

Gatter also said he had made previous payments in excess of \$5,000 for cement. He now has the money to make good the bad check.

In another case two 18-year-old East Hartford girls were given 60-day suspended sentences in Toland County Jail and placed on probation for one year for breach of peace.

The girls, Ellen Lynch and Marie E. Bernard, were arrested on complaint of the proprietor of the Tick Tock Restaurant, 241 Wall St. The restaurant owner told police the girls returned to the restaurant, Ave. 11 and used abusive language when they were told they could not enter after having been ordered out of the establishment two weeks ago.

Referring to their past records, which resulted in the girls being brought before juvenile authorities for breach of peace, Judge Francis T. O'Loughlin told them a stipulation of their probationary period would be that they must be at home before 8 o'clock at night. In addition, they were ordered to report to the probation officer once a week.

Ernest J. Bryson, 44, Brighton, Mass., who is now serving a 30-day sentence at Toland County Jail for passing a bad check, was given an indefinite continuing sentence for passing a bad check. Bryson issued a bad \$30 check for release from Rockville City Court a year ago and after he was extradited from Massachusetts to face charges in Superior Court here, he was sentenced to 30 days in jail for passing a bad check. Bryson also was fined \$100 for passing a bad check. The continuing sentence was given on charges of failure to modify and William C. Higgins, 34, Superior Court fine and \$200 City Court fine.

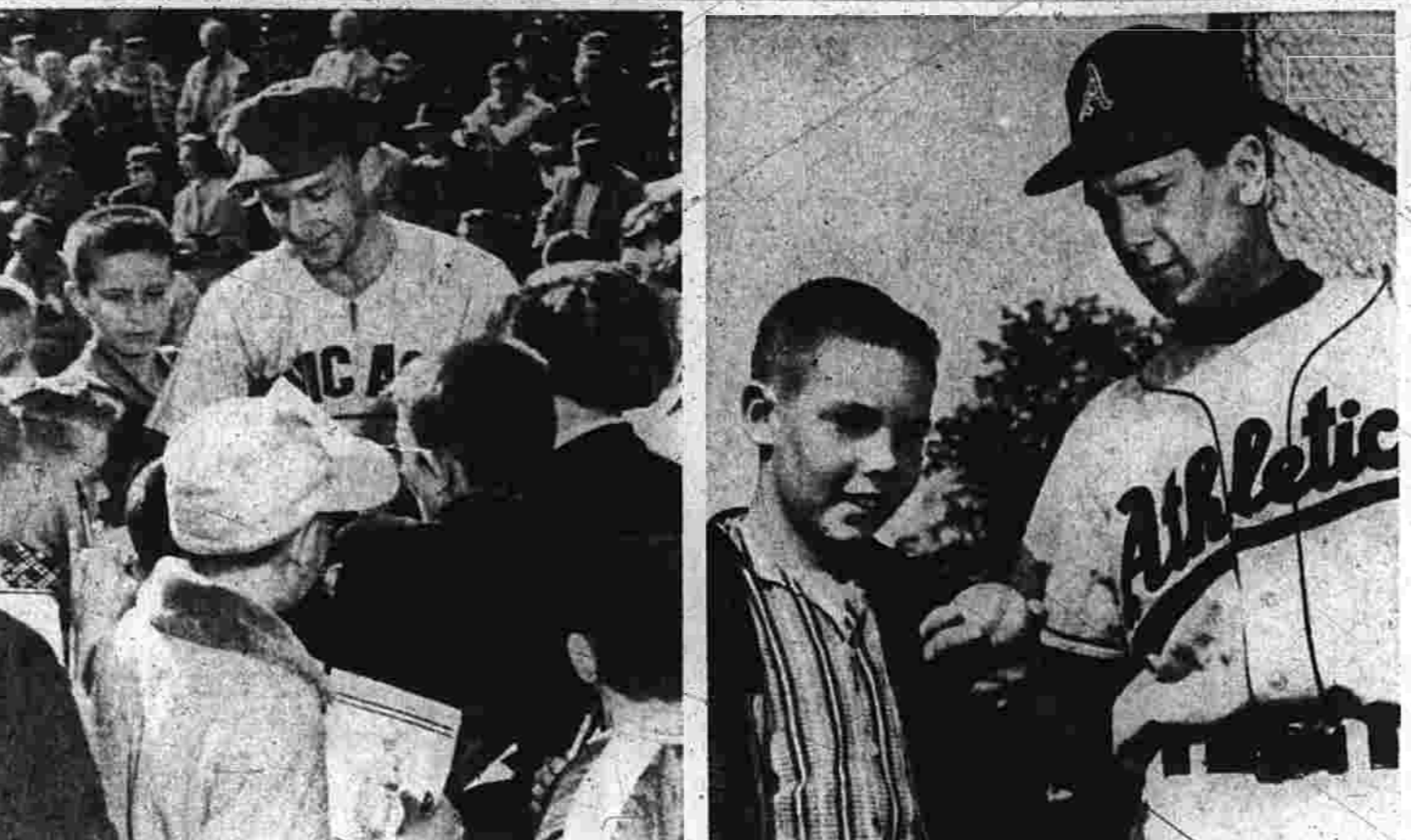
