U.S. Denies West Three Talks Now

Washington, Nov. 8 (AP)—President Eisenhower and Congressional leaders discussed the tense world situation for 2 1/2 hours today. The legislators left the White House using such terms as "grave" and "serious" but there were expressions also of optimism. Senate Democratic leader Lyndon Johnson of Texas told reporters he thought the discussion had been "very fruitful and helpful." "It's obvious that it is a very serious situation," Johnson said. House Republican leader Joseph W. Martin of Massachusetts said that "of course it is a grave situation but I am still optimistic about a settlement in the Middle East."
