### U.N. Says Hungary Enslaved by Reds

The U.N. Charter and 1947 Hungarian Peace Treaty, it also said foreign intervention there was an "intolerable attempt to deprive the people their rights."

The Assembly has passed two resolutions for relief to the Hungarian people. One, sponsored by the United States, was adopted 59-3 with 13 abstentions.

Assembly passed the latter, with 12 abstentions, an effort of Ceylon, India and Indonesia to amend it, as an act to remove all language referring to the state of Hungary.

The new withdrawal demand re-enforced a U.S. resolution the Assembly adopted 60-8 last Sunday. The Assembly repeated its request that U.N. Secretary General Dag Hammarskjöld investigate the situation in Hungary "through representatives named by him."

The newly adopted Austrian relief resolution appears to all countries to help Hammarskjöld in "large scale immediate aid to emergency, including medical supplies, food and clothing."

The Budapest broadcast also said it appeared Hungary was still in grip of a paralyzing general strike.

The statement purportedly sanctioned by both the government and Hungary's Communist party, appealed to workers to go back to their jobs. It said if this was not done, Hungary was threatened by inflation, a collapse of her economy.

Key Coal, Pool at Border

The government made an especially urgent appeal to railway employees to return to work.

"The population is cold and hungry while hundreds of railway cars with food and coal are waiting at the Hungarian border," the appeal added.

The statement said Karai's government had rejected efforts aimed at restoring the "Stalinist regime" of Matyas Rakosi, Hungary's longtime dictator and former Premier.

"We shall never return to the days of Stalinist despotism and Jewry," the statement said.

### Tolland County Superior Court

Rockville, Nov. 10 (Special)—A temporary injunction holding Judge John C. Fitzgerald in Tolland County Court of Common Pleas yesterday.

The injunction, granted to Walter Dobrowsky and a group of Somers residents, protested the joint action of the Somers Zoning Board and the Board of Appeals which gave a Joy Cooley property in a residential zone a commercial plant located on R. 1, N. north of Somers.

Plaintiffs protested the action of the two boards, claiming the plant is located in a residential zone and that an expansion permit was issued without a public hearing.

A suit appealing the ZBA decision has yet to be heard.

The accident from which the suit resulted occurred at Woodbridge and E. Center Sts., Manchester, July 28, 1955. The plaintiff was stopped at a stop sign and suffered injuries when a car operated by the defendant rammed the rear of the plaintiff's car.
