Hungary Still Winning?
 Out of the tragedy of Hungary, even in the moment when Russian military domination of that country has been made complete, hope still persists. It is the hope that the Russians are still being licked, in the midst of and because of their report to military forces. If they have been licked, if the Hun-garian revolution is still in the main a success at least comparable to the peaceful revolution in Poland, that will seem a miracle. But if it happens, it will be the kind of miracle that can always happen when mere physical force meets up with the united will and resolve of a population.

Kadar, the Russian puppet
 Kadar, the Russian puppet now trying to hold the helm in Hungary with the Russian troops in the back of him, has now proceeded from promise to promise until he has now promised almost everything his predecessor Nagy had promised, before Russian tanks despoised him. There is now no schedule that strength in his deal-ing with the Budapest Workers Council, the organization which is maintaining the general strike which is paralyzing the country. Today he is even back to prom-ising almost the very same thing Nagy was doing when he was de-spoised to negotiate for the grad-ual withdrawal of Russian troops from the country. He is not very far from dealing with Nagy him-self.

The Most Frightening Thing
 These are times for being frightened, times of frightening events and possibilities. We can feel that our very days of life may be numbered, and a shadow hangs before that possibility. Yet nothing, not even death itself, is more frightening than what goes on in the minds of men. And the most frightening thing we have encountered, in these days of frightfulness, is the kind of thinking by men revealed and advanced in an editorial of a great and respected newspaper, often believed to speak for Amer-ica, the great New York Times, discussing the present crisis in the Near East.

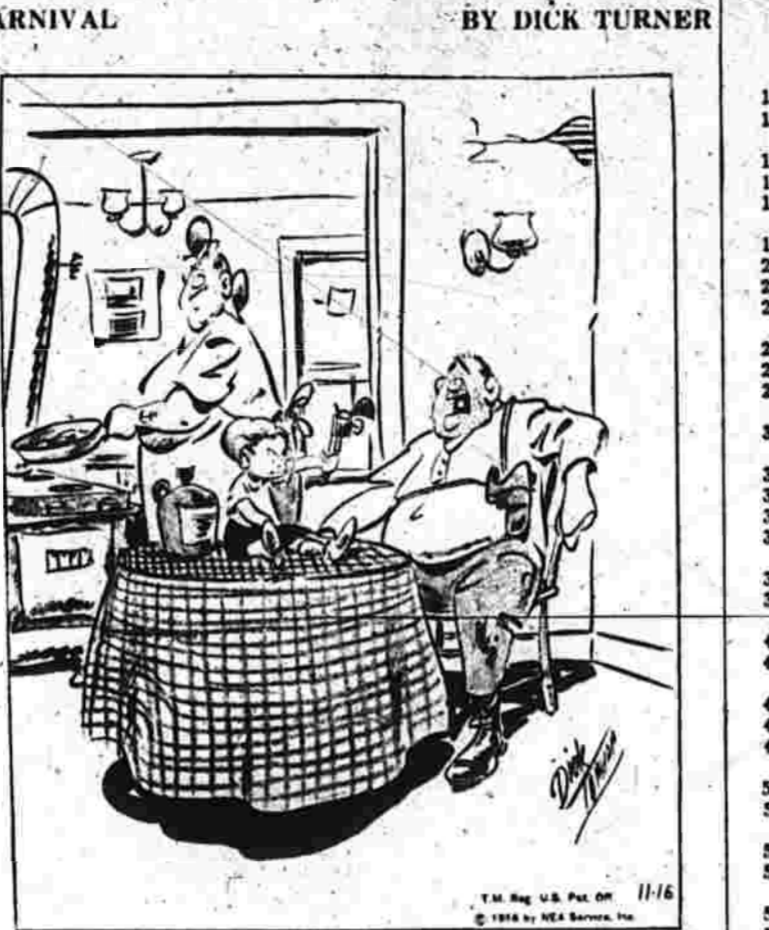

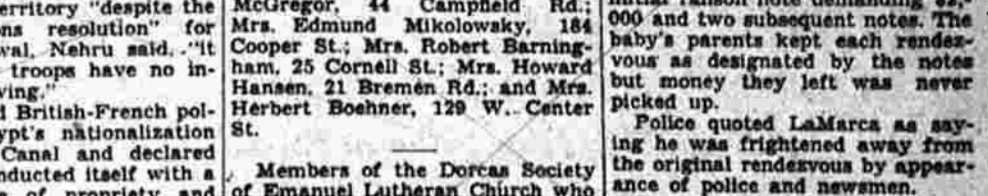
